Angela E. Rickford is a Professor of Education at San Jose State University in California, USA. She received her BA degree (with Special Honors) in English Literature from the University of the West Indies (Mona, Jamaica), her MSc. in Education with a Minor in Linguistics from the University of Pennsylvania, her teaching credentials from the University of Guyana, South America, and her PhD in Education with a Minor in Psychology from Stanford University. Her research is in the area of literacy development in ethnically diverse students. She has worked extensively with schools in training Reading teachers and literacy coaches, and has served as a literacy consultant for several organizations, including book publishers and school districts both in and out of California. Her publications include multiple journal articles and book chapters, including a 1999 book entitled, "I can fly: Teaching Narratives and Reading Comprehension to African American and other ethnic minority students."
