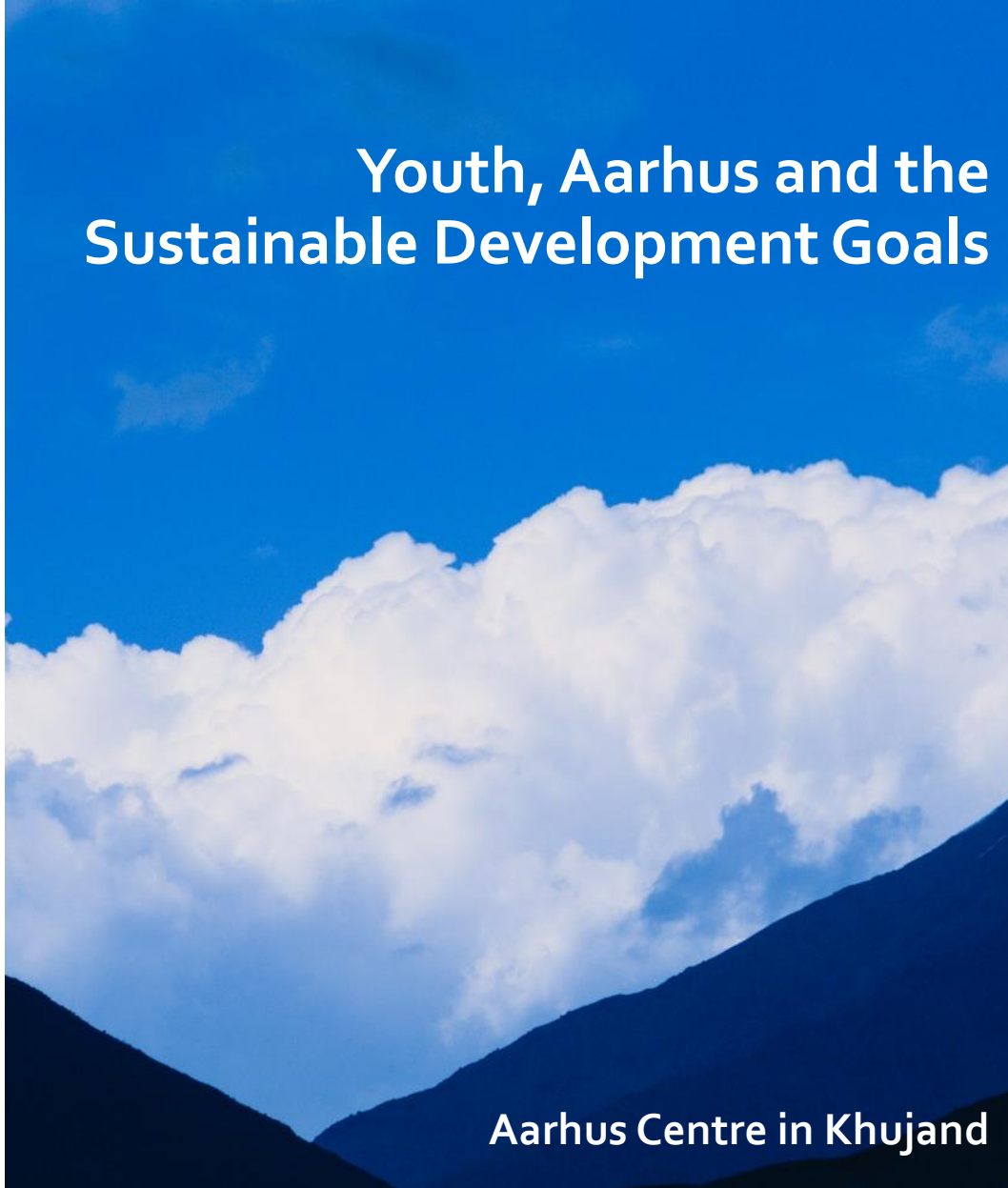
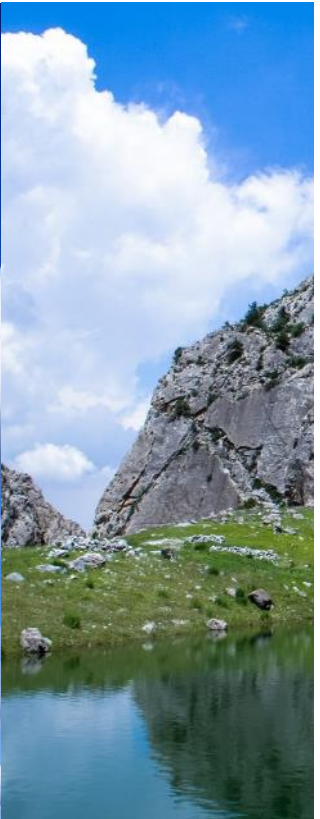

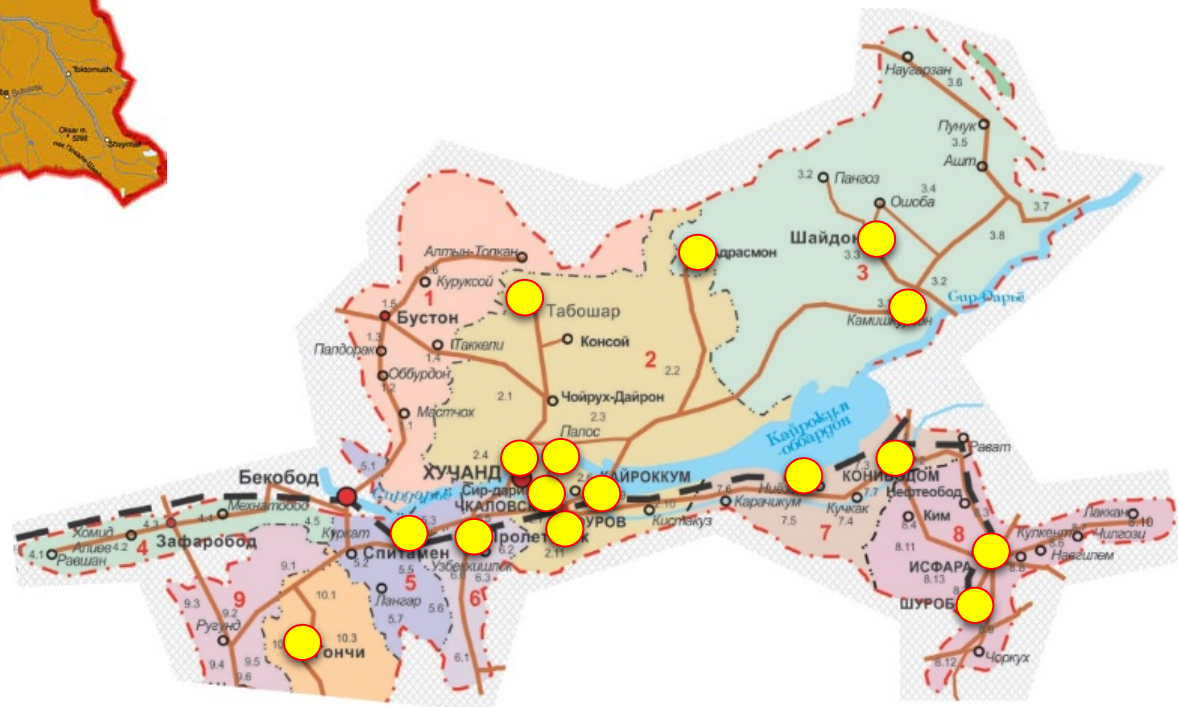

- Participation on the process of development of ecological strategies;





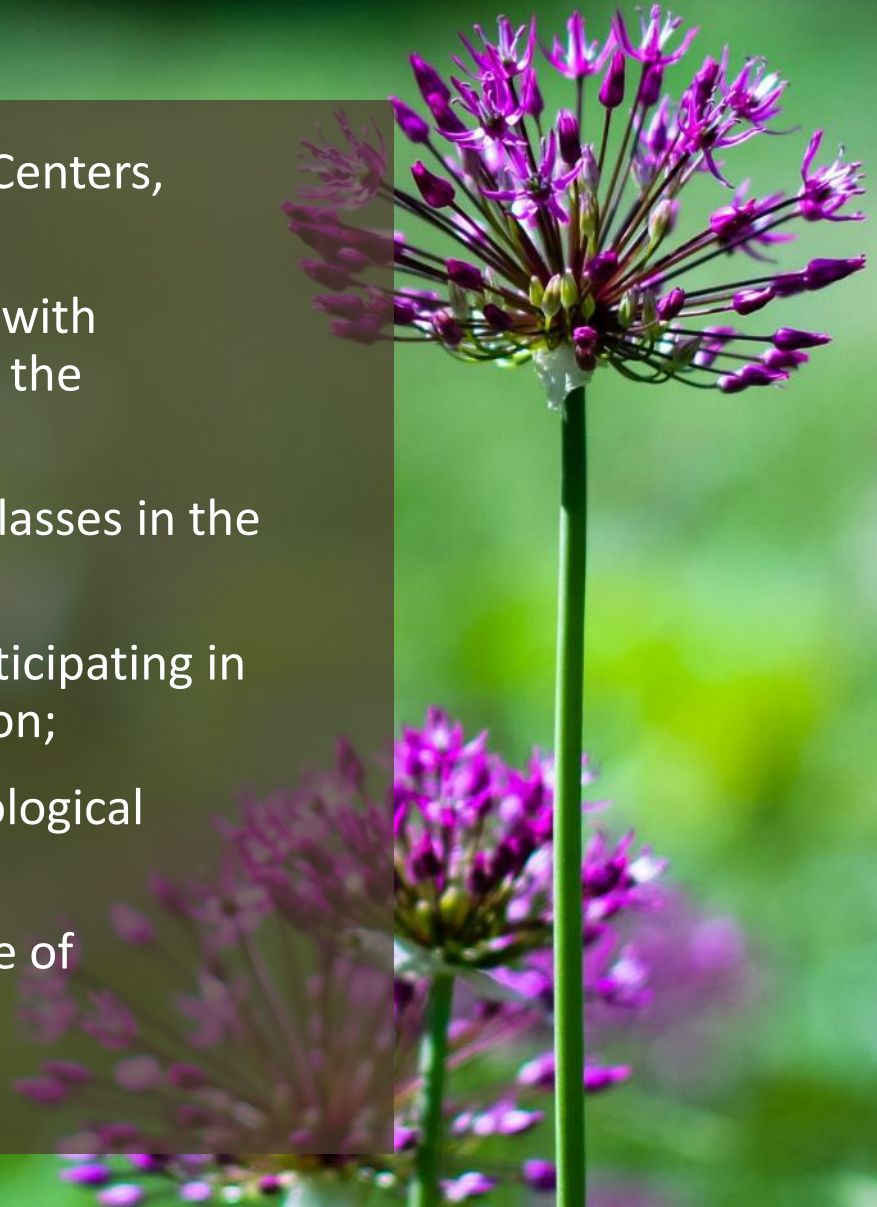
IMPLEMENTING PRACTICAL ACTIVITIES;

- Conducting of ecological monitoring in the target areas;
- Using of energy saving technologies;
- Conducting actions, festivals and competitions on the SDG goals;
- Restoration of flora and fauna;
- Conducting of cleaning up activities with government agencies and local population;
- Broadcasting TV Shows on ecological issues and access to the information.



Main results:

1. Always ON information exchange tools between Aarhus Centers, Youth and Partners;
2. Conducted more than 25 public environment monitoring with involvement of youth and provided recommendations to the government;
3. Graduates of ecological trainings conducting additional classes in the schools;
4. The youth movement of Istiqlol and Goziyon actively participating in the cooperation process of Uranium tailings rehabilitation;
5. The program GREEN PATROLS approved as additional ecological education on the Ministry of education in Tajikistan.
6. Strengthening of transboundary collaboration – exchange of experience, jointly activities (Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan)
