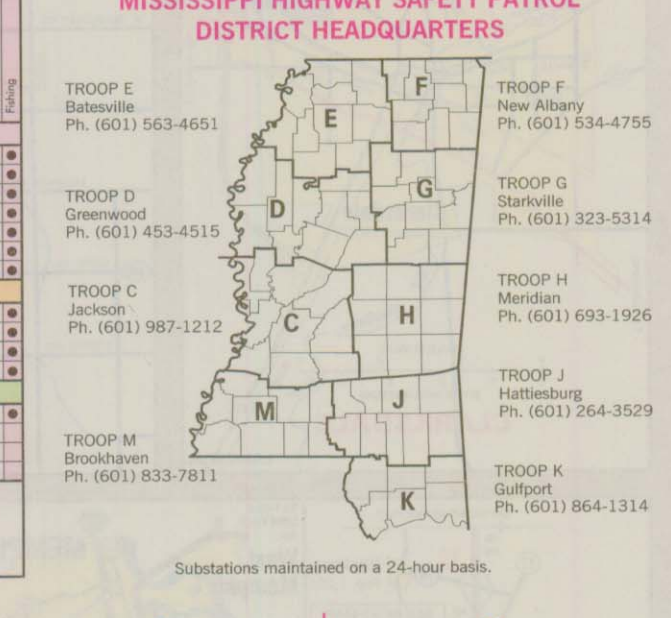

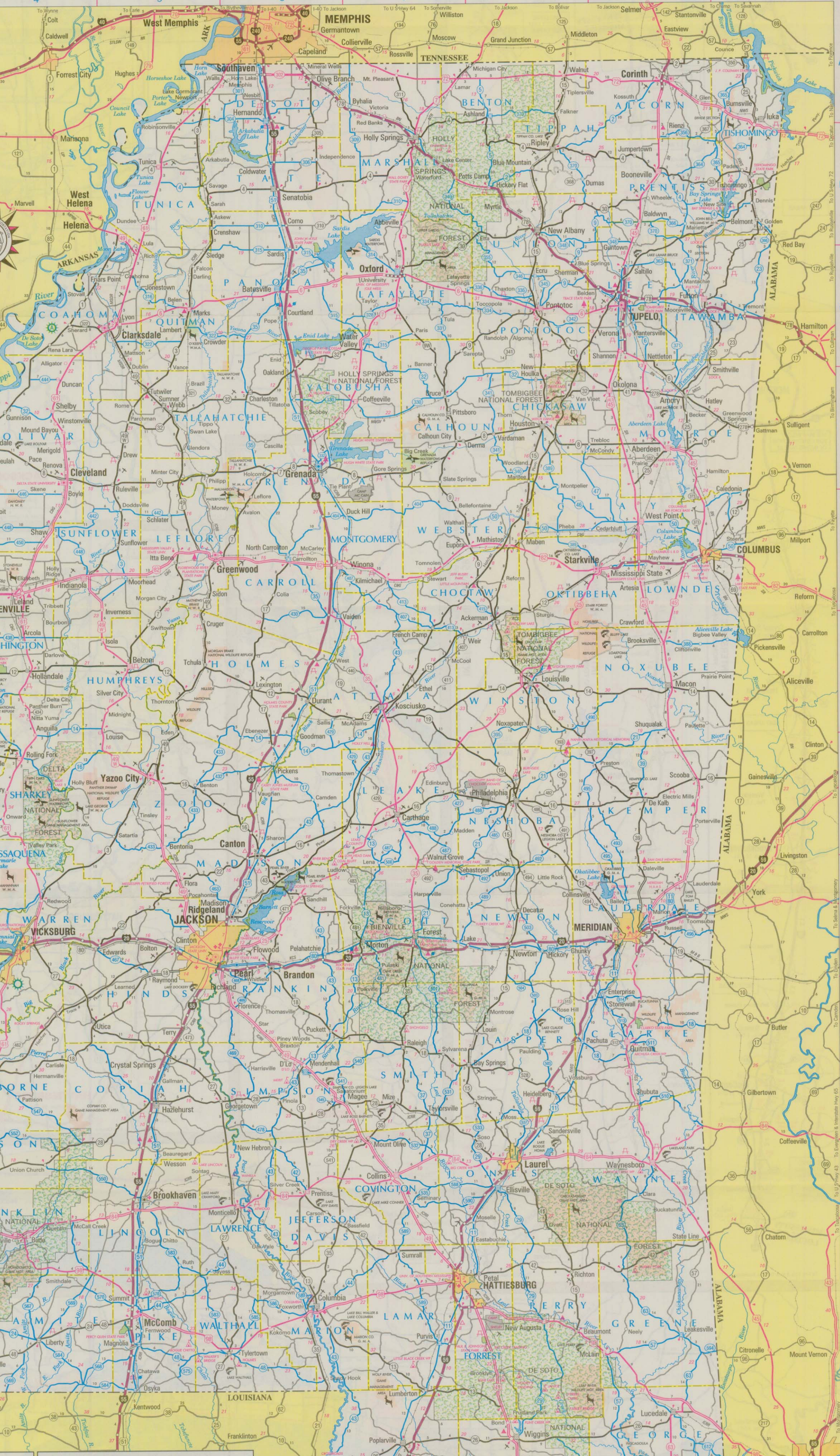

MISSISSIPPI BIKE LAWS

House Bill No. 559 of the Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature was an act to provide bicycles subject to the provisions of traffic law applicable to the drivers of motor vehicles, and to provide that every person riding a bicycle upon a highway shall have all the rights and duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle except those provisions which by their nature have no application.

Section 63-9-603 was amended to place certain regulations on persons riding bicycles on a roadway. Persons riding bicycles upon a roadway shall not ride more than two abreast on paths or parts of roadways set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles. Persons riding two abreast shall not impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic, and, on a multi-lane roadway shall ride in a single lane.

BIKE LAWS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON ANY INTERSTATE HIGHWAY IN THE STATE.
