VISA INFO

All players and their support team **MUST** apply for a Temporary Activity – Invited Participant Visa (subclass 408). Contact Player Relations players@atpcup.com.au to request letter of invitation. Players must allow sufficient time for their visa applications to be processed. Player guests can apply for tourist visas which don't need a letter of invitation. **Due to Australia Visa regulations, all visas should be submitted before 20 November.**

COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition is Round Robin format with six (6) groups of four (4) teams each. Each tie will comprise of two singles and a doubles match. All singles matches shall be the best of three (3) tie-break sets. All doubles matches shall be two (2) tie-break sets with a deciding Match Tie-Break (10 point) at one (1) set all. Each team shall play each other in its group to determine the top team in each group. The top team in each group plus the two (2) highest second-placed teams shall advance to the Quarter-Finals of the Final Eight stage. Each team will compose of a minimum of three (3) players and a maximum of five (5) players from the same country.

MATCH SCHEDULE

Group Stage Matches: Friday 3 - Wednesday 8 January **Final Eight, Sydney:** Thursday 9 – Sunday 12 January 2020

A day and evening session will be played at each venue, each day. Each session (tie) comprises of two singles and one doubles match. Day sessions start at 10:00am, and evening sessions start at 5.30pm (all local time).

Saturday day semi-final session starts at 11:00am, night semi-final starts at 6:30pm, Sunday Final starts at 6:30pm.

PRACTICE

Practice Courts and gyms in Brisbane, Perth and Sydney will be available for use from Saturday 21 December. During the event, Practice Matches with full scoring and officiating will be arranged each day, on-site for players

MATCH CLOTHING

The flag pertaining to each player's nationality will be added to the player's match clothing on-site by the tournament team, prior to the first match

An **undefeated singles player** who plays and wins all possible singles matches against top ranked singles players will earn a maximum of **750 ATP points**.

An **undefeated doubles player** who plays and wins all possible doubles matches will earn a maximum of **250 ATP points**.

ATP Singles Rankings points are awarded for a match win in each round and depend on the ranking of the opponent.

ATP Doubles Rankings points are awarded for a match win in each round and do not depend on the ranking of the opponents.

TAX INFO

Any player not moving onto another tournament in Australia needs to complete an Income Tax Return at the end of the tournament must provide evidence of the deductions to claim. If no evidence is provided the tax office may disallow the deduction. All players require an Australian Business Number (ABN) and a Tax File Number (TFN). Applications for a TFN and an ABN can be completed upon arrival at the event with the Prize Money Officer. You must bring with you the passport you entered Australia on (ideally the physical document but a clear picture of the passport will suffice). You can only apply for a TFN and an ABN when you are actually in Australia. If you have previously applied for a TFN and/or an ABN you do not have to complete the process again.

Players competing under a **Protected Ranking** will receive **50%** of the participation fee for that ranking. If the player competes in one group-stage match, he will receive **75%**. If he competes in two group-stage matches, he will receive **100%**.

Players may only receive a participation fee in one category, singles or doubles.

Team captains will also receive remuneration.

Singles line-up for the tie shall be based on ATP Ranking (including Protected Ranking) on the Monday prior to the start of the competition, based on the top two singles qualified players at the second entry deadline.
