NRJ calling for pan-European regulator

PARIS — One of Europe's leading broadcasters has called for the creation of a pan-European regulator to promote a more harmonised radio market in the European Union.

The plea was made by NRJ Group vice-president Marc Pallain during the ninth NAB European Radio Conference held in Paris, November 11-13.

Speaking during the "Regulation and Your Future" session, Pallain—whose group is present in nine different European countries—says that to grow in their own market, European operators need a level playing field.

"We are confronted with a diverse and non-homogeneous set of rules," he explained. "But our vocation is to be operating throughout Europe. It would be useful if, throughout Europe, there

was a certain common ground."

He added: "Radio is a sector in development and there are currently rules hindering this development." Pallain advocated "a greater opening up of the FM spectrum in all European countries," claiming there is a reservoir of untapped frequencies.

He called for the creation of a pan-European broadcast regulator whose task would be to organise co-regulation and to "implement a set of rules common to all countries."

Pallain said that regulators in France have always applied the "free trade" principle, allocating frequencies to non-French operators. "[Germany-based] Bertelsmann, through its affiliate RTL Group, is France's leading operator with some 500 frequencies," he noted.

Worldpop suffers from earthly woes

LONDON — Worldpop, the online music portal which sponsors the official UK charts, is in the hands of administrators.

It had been known that the London-based internet company was in financial difficulties and, on November 6, it announced its intention to cut down on staff. The cuts are believed to number around 30.

Worldpop was the subject of a consultancy period up until November 13, when the High Court ruled that the company should be put in the hands of joint administrators Mike Jervis and Nick Wood, partners at accountancy giant Grant Thornton.

Jervis tells M&M that within hours of being appointed he had more than 20 inquiries about the business. "We are looking for further investment at the moment, or perhaps selling the business," he says.

Worldpop was founded in 1999 by four entrepreneurs, including the former BBC Radio 1 DJ Peter Powell. The site features music news, reviews, ringtones and music downloads, in addition to UK and global charts.

Worldpop began its sponsorship of the official UK album and singles charts last year, following a controversial deal with UK labels' body BPI and retailers association BARD, which meant that UK public broadcaster the BBC had to name-check Wordpop every time it broadcast the official charts. The deal was criticised on the grounds that programmes aired by the BBC are not allowed to be sponsored.

Wordpop's staff have been guaranteed payment until the end of this month, and there will be no immediate redundancies. It is anticipated the company will become profitable next year.

This time Sting shows his fragile side

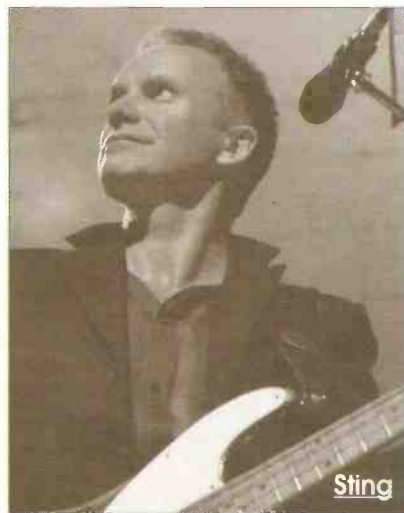
LONDON — "This was meant to be a joyful experience, but now it can't be."

That's how Sting addressed a crowd of 200 guests gathered outside his mansion in Tuscany on September 11, a few hours after the events in the US, writes Emmanuel Legrand.

The audience, comprising media and competition winners from all over the world, had initially come for what Universal Music International senior VP of marketing and A&R Max Hole describes as a "festive revisitation of his career both as a member of the Police and as a solo act," but instead became part of "a reflective evening."

Hole says that the events in the US "simply gave the performance an emo-

Upfront

For a snapshot of the current state of European radio, the best place to be was at the NAB European Radio show in Paris last week.

Although one of the words most heard was "crisis", broadcasters were putting on a brave face and hoping that the current turmoil will soon be forgotten in 2002.

Aside from the usual sales pitch of the numerous consultants present, the NAB show demonstrated that there is a real wealth of diversity and talent in radio throughout Europe, and that European broadcasters can learn from each other (apart from many French radio executives in the neighbourhood who failed to pay the conference a visit).

In contrast to previous occasions, the idea of a pan-European regulator for radio was seriously entertained by many participants. In this regard, the NAB's regulators summit delivered the goods. It's not too often that you get to see the people who have the final say on radio operators,

and the presence of France's Dominique Baudis and the UK's Tony Stoller was in itself an event.

It was also interesting from a cultural perspective. The Frenchman pleaded the case for regulators, at both a national and pan-European level. Meanwhile, Stoller's Radio Authority will disappear to make way for a "super regulator" which will subsume it.

And sat in the middle was Marc Pallain from NRJ. As a representative of a group which wants to operate without boundaries across the whole of Europe, he is against too much local regulation but is in favour of a level playing field across Europe—making the need for a pan-European regulator a necessity.

To sum up NRJ's position, it's about having more pan-European legislation, and less local regulation, for the benefit of international operators.

The end goal is to create the proper conditions for truly pan-European groups to thrive. And for that to succeed, it needs the support of all European broadcasters.

Deejay feels the September 11 effect

MILAN — One of the first European ratings surveys to be published covering September 11 and its aftermath reveals the kind of audience hit that most music stations can expect to take.

According to third quarter figures for the period September 15 to October 26 released by Italian ratings body Audiradio, CHR network Radio Deejay has slipped from second to third place, its position being taken by public full-service station RAI Radio 2.

All-news station Radio 24—co-owned by Editoriale Sper and financial newspaper Il Sole 24 Ore—saw its daily audience increase by 50% to 1.5 million.

"The stations with strong news coverage have done very well," confirms Audiradio president Felice Lioy. "I'm referring not only to Radio 24 and the three RAI stations, but also to those music networks with in-depth report-

ing like RTL 102.5 Hit Radio."

Pietro Varvello, managing-director of Elemedia, the company which owns Radio Deejay as well as Radio Capital and Italia Radio, says: "Needless to say, we're not happy about these figures, but at the same time we're not unduly worried as this is a freak situation caused by the events of September 11 and their aftermath. And, if the truth be known, Radio Deejay traditionally sees a bit of a drop-off in autumn after the peaks of the summer."

In the weeks prior to the release of the figures, criticism was levelled at Audiradio for producing statistics that it is claimed favour public broadcaster RAI. Lioy dismisses the criticisms as unfounded. "Sure, when we conduct our phone surveys, we do ask people whether they listen to RAI stations, but we then ask them whether they listen to commercial

stations. I mean, how can we possibly be biased in favour of the RAI when our research shows that 75% of the audience now listens to commercial radio?"

Quarter-on-quarter, the overall number of daily listeners increased from 34.9 million to 35.4 million.

MTV Europe Awards take the Bizkit

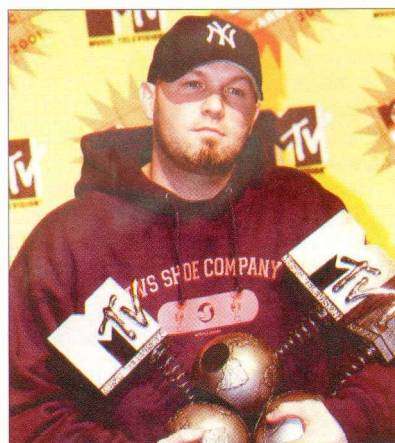

FRANKFURT — Universal underlined its status as the world's largest record company by topping eight of the 22 categories at this year's MTV Europe Music Awards in Frankfurt on November 8.

The label's Interscope act Limp Bizkit were the stars of the night, taking home the awards for Best Group, Best Album for *Chocolate Starfish and the Hot Dog Flavored Water* and the Web Award—all voted for by MTV viewers.

"It was great that Fred Durst [pictured] was there to celebrate and collect three awards for Limp Bizkit, the most successful American group in the world today," Max Hole, senior VP marketing and A&R, Universal Music International told M&M afterwards.

Despite the repercussions of September 11, organisers said they were



happy with how the event went.

"It went extremely well, what we've been having back is positive," says MTV CEO & president Brent Hansen, who admits that "it hasn't been the easiest year to book artists," but compared to last year, which saw both Madonna and U2 perform, "this

year's line-up was consistent, perhaps more so than last year. We have taken the show forward."

EMI and Telstar got two key awards each. Parlophone act Gorillaz took Best Song for *Clint Eastwood* and Best Dance Award, while Telstar UK garage artist Craig David secured Best R&B Act and Best UK & Ireland Act.

Samy Deluxe took home Best German Act as part of the regional awards, which were screened to the individual feeds.

"To be honoured as the number one German artist is a fantastic achievement for Samy Deluxe," comments director promotion EMI Electrola Susanne Hort. "It was great to see the EMA's back in Germany."

Universal act Safri Duo took Best Nordic Act, while Manu Chao (Virgin) took Best French Act and La Oreja De Van Gogh (Sony) secured the Best Spanish Act award.

Universal names new GMs

VIENNA — Vico Antippas, Universal Music president Germany, Switzerland and Austria, has named new general managers for the label's Austrian and Swiss operations.

Bogdan Roscic moves from the radio sector to become general manager of Universal Music Austria, while an internal promotion moves Ivo Sacchi up to the position of general manager, Universal Music Switzerland.

Roscic, former general manager and programme director at public CHR station ORF Ö3, will begin taking up his responsibilities in mid-November, and will assume the role with full effect from January 1.

"I am delighted to have secured someone of Bogdan's calibre for the position of

general manager," says Antippas. "With his profound experience and knowledge of Austrian media and the Austrian music scene, he will give vital impulses to



this troubled music market and lead Universal Austria from strength to strength."

Prior to his Ö3 post, Roscic was head of media and pop at national daily newspaper Kurier, and was media and music editor of national daily Die Presse.

He says: "I am very much looking forward to further expanding Universal Music's leadership position in Austria and to working with the tal-

ented team in place today."

Ivo Sacchi was marketing manager at Sony Music Switzerland before moving to Universal Music Switzerland, where he has been marketing director since November 1999.

"I have enjoyed the challenges as marketing director," he says. "And I now look forward to leading this exciting company into the future and to help further expand our market leadership."

Commenting on Sacchi's appointment, Antippas says: "I am delighted that we have the management potential inside our Swiss company to fill the newly-created position of general manager. Sacchi is highly regarded in Switzerland's music, media and entertainment circles."

Both executives will report directly to Antippas.

NYBERG NAMED PRESIDENT OF DAB FORUM



BRUSSELS — Annika Nyberg (pictured), director of programmes for the Swedish-language service of Finnish public broadcaster YLE, has been elected president of the World DAB Forum. Nyberg is charged with steering the international rollout of digital radio over the next two years. The forum represents companies and organisations from all sectors of the broadcast industry from 25 countries and aims to promote and co-ordinate the implementation of digital radio world-wide. Nyberg replaces incumbent Michael McEwen, who has reached the end of his four-year tenure.

VIVA ACQUIRES BRAINPOOL

BERLIN — Viva Media has bought 64.5% of Brainpool TV, the German company which produces comedy formats for commercial television, to create a music TV and youth entertainment media group. Brainpool CEO Jörg Grabosch has joined Viva Media's management board, while Viva CEO Dieter Gorny and CFO Christian Gisy take up seats on the Brainpool board. Claus Dieter Grabner is leaving Brainpool's board.

SUNNY LUNA NAMES MANAGER

MADRID — Domingo García has been named label manager of Sunny Luna, the new Madrid-based label created jointly by Gran Via Musical (GVM), Sony Music Entertainment, and Emilio Estefan's Miami-based Crescent Moon label. García, who is currently label manager of GVM's MuXXIc label, is moving to Sunny Luna in January. Ignacio Iglesias, GM of GVM, says the label's first releases will be by Crescent Moon acts. Titles will come out initially in Spain, for later release worldwide. GVM holds 60% of Sunny Luna, with the rest split between Sony and Crescent Moon. Sunny Luna will distribute and market Crescent Moon artists in Spain. The latter label's GM, Mauricio Abaroa, will handle Sunny Luna's A&R activities in Miami.

MTV LAUNCHES INTERACTIVE SERVICE

LONDON — MTV Networks Europe has launched its first interactive TV application in the UK and Ireland. The enhanced service is available to subscribers of Sky Digital TV and enabled viewers to vote via remote control for the winners before and during the MTV Europe Music Awards. MTV Networks Europe is also introducing a branded mobile information service in conjunction with Swiss-based wireless application service provider Disterfora Mobile. MTV Mobile will be localised for the various markets in which the broadcaster has a presence and will be available to about 70% of European mobile users.

Warner, VMM team up to promote Q-Music

BRUSSELS — Warner Music Belgium and media group VMM have joined up to promote the launch of the latter's new Flanders-wide station, Q-Music.

A Warner compilation album, *The Sound Of Q-Music*, features 20 tracks which will be cornerstones of the playlist at the Hot AC station, which was granted a "national" Flanders-wide licence last month.

Tracks on the album include Robbie Williams' *Road To Madalay*, Natalie Imbruglia's *Torn*, Nelly Furtado's *I'm Like A Bird*, *Wrong* by Belgian band Novastar, and Jamiroquai's *Canned Heat*.

Launched three weeks before the station officially went on air on November

12, *The Sound Of Q-Music* has reached number two in the Flemish Ultratop album chart.

"The idea [for the album] came during a marketing meeting we had with



VMM," says Peter Soetewey, marketing manager at Warner Music Strategic Marketing. "It's an absolute first for this type of CD to be released before the actual launch of the media partner."

Q-Music is owned by VMM, which, apart from owning TV stations, also

runs the dance and full-service networks Top Radio and Mango Radio. It was granted, along with 4FM, a nine-year licence from the Flemish government to provide a national commercial competitor to public broadcaster-VRT Radio. Whereas 4FM will have a broad-based format targeting a family audience, Q-Music is aiming its output at a slightly younger demographic.

Q-Music's station manager is former Radio Donna station director Bert Geenen, who has hired former Radio Donna presenters Deckers and Ornelis and Alexandra Potvin for the new station.

As well as the publicity from the album, VMM has also been running a print campaign to promote the station's arrival.

It's Alcazar's party and they'll cry if they want to

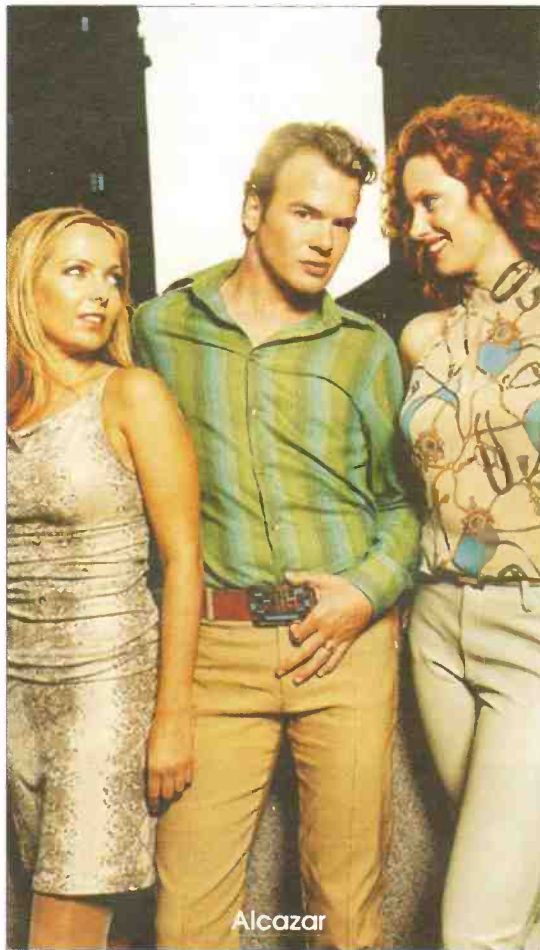

The tried and tested formula for cracking Europe is to break out of your home territory first. Swedish act Alcazar reversed the formula by going to number one in the Finnish dance chart before Sweden was ready to import their slick disco grooves.

After signing to the local BMG affiliate two years ago, debut album *Crying* (Ariola) was released in Sweden in May 2000, but "it didn't really work," according to BMG Sweden managing director Björn Lindborg. But last October a succession of club tours coupled with a strong video started to have an impact in Finland, resulting in *Crying At The Discotheque* topping the Finnish dance chart. "After that, the track ended up in France in February this year," says Lindborg. *Casino* samples the 1979 disco track *Spacer* by French act Sheila and B. Devotion and went on to sell 30,000 units in France, where it also went to number one in that country's dance chart.

After, Alcazar went to Italy on a TV and club promo trip, "we had a massive hit there in July—it was on the top 10 for 11 weeks," says Lindborg. "The band was even awarded best international act at the Italian summer roadshow Festivalbar. Next to pick it up was BMG Hamburg, who managed a massive radio hit in Germany in September."

To date, the track has made the top 10 in eight European countries, peaked at 22 in M&M's Eurochart Hot 100 Singles and sold half a million copies in Europe—300,000 of these in Germany where it peaked at number two in the singles chart. "If it hadn't been for September

11, I am pretty sure it could have gone to number one in Germany, but Enya (*Only Time*) took that spot," Lindborg adds.

Despite the success of the single, *Casino* has sold slowly in Germany. Released on October 8, and scheduled for release in the rest of Europe at the end of the year, the album has so far sold 35,000 units in the country, but should be boosted by the release of a second single, *Sexual Guarantee*, on November 19. The track features samples from another old disco tune, Chic's *My Forbidden Lover*.

On the same day as the act's second single comes out in Germany, *Crying* is to be released in the UK. The single is gaining airplay, and is currently top five on Kiss TV and top 10 on The Box. The reason, according to Lindborg, is "the video is very different [and] it's classic disco with up-to-date beats and a group made up of born entertainers".

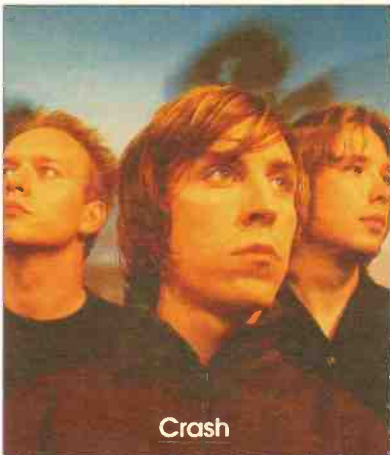
"We thought the video was quite quirky and we liked the song too," says head of music at The Box in the UK, Lee Thompson. "It's a great pop tune, a good crossover. Looking at the national picture, it's a better bet for us than the London garage two-step types."

So what about Sweden? Ironically, Lindborg believes Alcazar might be a bit too Swedish for Sweden. "We really believed in this becoming a huge hit in Europe—it's very disco, Abba and Swedish. So maybe it's more for other countries than for Sweden. Sweden comes properly on board with the next single, and then the album will be re-released here next year. It has taken a long while, but now Alcazar are a big priority for BMG all over Europe."

Finnish rockers crash the charts

The Crash were preparing for the release of their sophomore album *Wildlife* (Warner)—with their first single *Lauren Caught My Eye* already in radio rotation—when the terrorist attacks in the US

changed the Finnish group's plans.

"I had talked with our production manager on September 11, before the attacks, that [our song] *New York* should be the next single. It felt like the worst possible choice the day after," confesses singer-guitarist Teemu Brunila, who writes the band's songs and produced *Wildlife*. Instead, the follow-up single is the album's most Bowie-esque tune, *Star*, which is already in rotation on national public CHR station Radiomafia.

"Lauren is an updated '80s-influenced sound for The Crash and the new direction suits them—and radio," says Radiomafia head of music Ville Vilén. Their trademark, the singer's special voice, of course remains". *Lauren Caught My Eye*, featuring a catchy French-language chorus, entered at number three in the Finnish singles chart—as did *Wildlife* in the album chart.

The Crash got their big break in 1998, prior to the release of their debut album *Comfort Deluxe*, when Radiomafia added the demo *Sugared* to their playlist.

"Personally I think it is the finest Finnish pop-rock tune of the '90s," says Vilén. The song was also picked up in Austria, but German radio neglected it.

"We had good reviews and a lot of promotion there, but radio felt *Sugared* was too sad," Brunila explains.

Wildlife is slated for a Scandinavian release in early 2002 with Germany and other European territories to follow, according to Warner Finland's international co-ordinator Tuomo Korpinen. The debut was released in ten countries. "The Crash have a good fan-base abroad and fans have approached us through the thecrash.com website from various countries asking for new material. Swedish radio has also asked after *Lauren* already," Korpinen adds.

DANCE GROOVES

MAGIC BOX OF HITS

4 *Your Love* by Magic Box (Spy Records/Italy) thumps along in a charming, playful, very Italian way until the arrival of a trancy breakdown accompanied by a sparkling falsetto vocal that should guarantee plenty of European radio plays. According to Time Records' Paolo Caputo (Spy records is a subsidiary of the Brescia-based operation), the track is already scoring highly with Italian programmers: "4 *Your Love* is going very, very well in Italy," Caputo reports. "It's top 10 in all the important radio charts and is on heavy rotation right across the country." The track entered the top 60 of the Italian sales chart last week.



Magic Box

NEWCOMER BLUES

With global sales of Llorca's sleek, delightful debut album, *Newcomer* (F Communications/France), now going past the 100,000 mark, the release of a set of remixes of stand-out track *Indigo Blues*—written by and featuring the vocals of Nicole

Graham—should see the album's profile further heightened. "It's really too early to say how the track will shape up as we have just the one 12-inch out," says F Communications' international manager Christophe Lebreton. "However, we are currently producing a CD-maxi for radio and Llorca is doing dates around Europe for the next four months."

RED HOT DANISH

Brother Brown's prog house remix of *We Dont Talk* (Iceberg-Big Star/Denmark) by Danish duo Ortz has recently topped no less than three Danish charts—DJ Favourite, Club Chart and the Danish Hype Chart—plus it was nominated "tune of the week" on Danish national radio (DR). *WDT* started life as a down-tempo tune that first came to prominence in Ibiza this summer. The original version and the Alaska remix were played at Cafe Del Mar, Cafe Mambo, Savannah, etc, all through the season. More recently the track got 40 spins in one week on DR and has spent a total of 12 weeks among the top 20 most played tracks on national radio. "We expect when the single is released that it will go top 20," says Oliver Zahringer, A&R manager at Big Star. "The Brother Brown Remix has been getting support at both house and prog house club nights plus various trance DJs have been supporting it, which confirms that it has wide appeal."

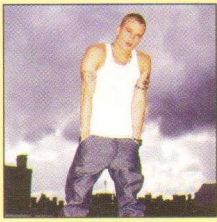

VINCENS WHO GOT PLAYED (WEA)

Release date: November 5 (Norway)

Norwegian R&B artists are few and far between, so 22-year-old Vincens' pop-take on the genre has been warmly welcomed by Norwegian radio. *Who Got Played* is the second single from the WEA artist, whose debut album *Play For Real* was released in his home country on October 22. Melodic R&B pop track *Who Got Played* is currently at six in the Norwegian airplay chart, and is enjoying massive airplay on radio across the formats. Meanwhile, Vincens is working the rest of Scandinavia, where his first single *Where's The Love Gone* is starting to get airplay. The album will be released there in the New Year. Head of music at public CHR station NRK Petre, Atle Bredal, has placed the new single straight on the station's A-list. "We are playing it because it's good and we are supporting Vincens as a new Norwegian talent," he says. "It's about time we had some Norwegian R&B pop—we should have had it a long time ago. It's one of the most expanding genres in Norway," he says, adding that "it's become more accepted to do pure pop or R&B in Norway. It always had to be rock before." SSD

LADYTRON PLAYGIRL (Invicta Hi Fi/Virgin) Release date single: November 19

Playgirl is the fourth single taken from Ladytron's debut album *604* and, like its predecessors, was chosen as Single of the Week by influential UK music paper the NME. The four-piece formed in 1999 in Liverpool and are fronted by Helen Marnie, vocals and keyboards, and native Bulgarian DJ and vocalist Mira Aroyo. Their male counterparts Reuben Wu, an acclaimed DJ, and experimental producer Daniel Hunt provide the background music of rhythm boxes and keyboards. *Playgirl* is a very accessible pop track heavy on synthesizers with a catchy hook and disco feel that creates a light-hearted, danceable and upbeat tune. Mira's soft, fragile and slightly detached voice is the perfect complement to the industrial, retro sound. The single comes in a huge remix pack containing nine different versions, including remixes by top dance acts/producers such as Felix Da Houscat, I Monster and Zombie Nation. Alastair Brown, head of music at the CHR/Alternative Student Broadcast Network in the UK, says: "Some of the remixes on the single are great. They draw influences from the electronica of the '80s, so I would describe it as an '80s electro dance groove. I think they have potential to break through to the mainstream." MH

DANCE BEAT

The weekly dance chart comment by Harald Roth

iiO's *Rapture* (Made/Ministry Of Sound) has climbed to number two this week, and is getting dangerously close to Kylie Minogue's massively successful *Can't Get You Out Of My Head* (Parlophone), at number one on the Dance Traxx chart for the third week running.

Club chart entries in the Netherlands and Portugal, plus dance retail debuts in the UK, Ireland, the Netherlands and Belgium, makes *Rapture* a serious contender for the top spot. Not a bad achievement for a previously virtually unknown act.

Purple Eye Entertainment-signed Dutch act Barthezz climb from 15 to 11 with a second top 10 entry, *Infected*. The track, a follow-up to *On The Move*, is proving to be a floor-filler in the Benelux territories, Germany and Hungary. Meanwhile, fellow Dutch act Charlie Lownoise & Mental Theo have moved their classic *Wonderful Days* (Seashore) into contemporary mode and manage and enter the top 10 at 10 this week. The track has received most support in Germany, where Kontor Records owns the local licence.

Also breaking into the top 10 this week is Roger Sanchez's *You Can't Change Me* (R-Senal/Defected & Sony), which features fellow American Armand van Helden and former Brand New Heavies singer N'Dea Davenport. The track rockets from number 48 to eight in only its second week in the top 100. It is already ranked second on the Movers Chart.

The tiny Belgian label A&S Records has already shown its strength with releases such as *Castles In The Sky* by Ian van Dahl featuring Marsha, which is spending its 25th week in the chart. Now, *Something* by labelmate Lasgo moves from 23 to 13 this week, due to an excellent chart run in Scandinavia. The track is licensed to Danish label Iceberg Records in the territory. Meanwhile, Dutch-signed Belgians Svenson & Gielen *Twisted* (ID&T) are new at 48 this week, and look likely to enter the top 40 shortly.

Finally, Moloko's Roisin Murphy has teamed up with The Psychedelic Waltons on new track *Wonderland* (Echo), which is enjoying massive airplay in the UK and looks set to cross over to other European territories soon.

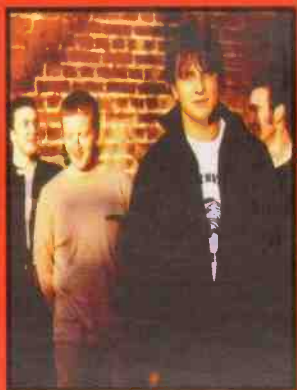

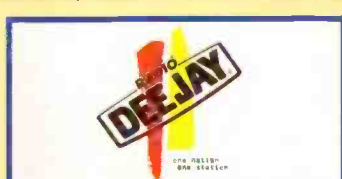

ON THE AIR

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

When Michael Jackson's (pictured) comeback number *You Rock My World* (Epic) entered the European Radio Top 50 at number five 10 weeks ago, it took the living legend only one week to knock labelmate Jennifer Lopez's *Ain't It Funny* off the top spot, and Jackson has stayed at number one ever since. New track *Cry*, the second single off his current album *Invincible*—which, incidentally, went straight in at number one on M&M's European Top 100 Albums chart last week—is the highest new entry in the airplay chart this week. Coming in at 38, *Cry* is not even close to the impressive start of *You Rock My World*, but still tops the Most Added chart this week.



CHR station Eins Live/Cologne in Germany, UK AC/MOR station BBC Radio 2 and full service station Rai Uno in Italy are among a number of significant stations to pick up the track this week. "It's a great song, you can tell it's written by R. Kelly," enthuses Eins Live's head of music Stephan Laack. But he adds: "Michael Jackson is having difficulties in Germany. The album only stayed at number one for two weeks and the first single didn't even make it into the top five. However, this is a good Michael Jackson song which could sell more, and also lift the album."

Despite having topped the European sales charts, Kylie Minogue's (pictured) *Can't Get You Out Of My Head* (Parlophone) still sits in the shadow of Jackson on European radio, at number two for yet another week. But the good news for the sassy singer is that the track is the top selling single so far this year in



Norway. 25,000 units have been shifted in the country to date, according to EMI Norway. The reward for Kylie's Norwegian followers is that Minogue will play Oslo Spektrum in May next year as part of her European tour.

Originally released back in September 2000, Dandy Warhols' *Bohemian Like You* (Capitol) is being re-released in Europe, and is already looking likely to do much better than the first time around, entering at 45 this week. The *Brown Sugar*-reminiscent track is a big hit on music TV, with its karaoke-themed video. Stations who have added the track this week include alternative stations ORB Fritz in Potsdam, Germany and Beat 106 in Glasgow, Scotland, as well as national CHR station Los 40 Principales in Spain.

At Eins Live, Laack didn't play the song the first time around, but has added it this week. "I saw them live in small clubs in Germany, playing for about 200 people. They haven't really been successful here until now," he says. "Because of the Vodafone ad, it's on TV all the time, so people should know it by now and we think it can do well in the German charts."

tional quality that was unique. In a way, Sting and his musicians gave one of the best performances of their lives."

The performance, which was due to be webcast and recorded for a live album, had been planned for almost a year.

"It was a fabulous evening," recalls Gary Bones, producer at national UK AC/MOR station BBC Radio 2. "The major difficulty was when we got to the hotel room we discovered the New York event was happening. We then went to Sting's at five o'clock to interview him, but we didn't feel it was right."

Bones continues: "When he came on, as a mark of respect, Sting said he was going to do one song, *Fragile*, then close down the webcast, and then it would be up to us—the audience—whether the band continued playing. So, after *Fragile* and a minute's silence, everyone started cheering, and the songs took on an extra meaning."

Hole tells M&M that the live album project coincided with Sting's tour and was planned as a follow-up to his seven-million selling album *Brand New Day*.

Says Hole: "Several concerts were recorded during the tour and there would have been a possibility of a live album, but after listening to the tapes, Sting did not feel inspired—the songs were good, but not exciting enough for him. So he came with the idea to do something small and intimate at his home in Italy, taking some of his songs and re-arranging them. It was a sort of review of his career."

...*All This Time* was released on A&M on November 5, and went straight to number four on M&M's European Top 100 Albums chart. The first single released was *Fragile*, but Hole says that "it was not meant to be the single. Sting chose that song because of its lyrical relevance. After the webcast, it was a no-brainer—it had to be the single."

The target set by Universal—three to four million units worldwide—might sound ambitious for a live album, but as Hole points out, Sting's previous album sold seven million worldwide, and he toured for almost two years playing to a total audience of close to three million people. "*Brand New Day* was his best selling album as a solo act," notes Hole.

To promote the album, Sting did promotion in the major territories, appearing in prestigious TV shows such as *Parkinson* in the UK and *Wetten Das* in Germany. Lee Ellen Newman, VP of promotions & artist relations at UMI, says: "There is a TV special that has been placed on TV shows all around the world. There is also a companion film in the making of the recording and lots of behind the scenes footage and interviews with Sting, and that too will be available for broadcast."

Hole concludes: "It's a special record and we are treating it as such. And so is Sting."

Sabot set to revive Lagardère stations

PARIS — A major reorganisation of French communication group Lagardère Media's radio and TV operations sees the return of former NRJ group programme director Christophe Sabot to a prominent position.

Sabot, who departed a few weeks ago from independent radio group LV&Co, where he was managing director, has been appointed MD of Lagardère's FM radio activities, which comprise Hot AC station Europe 2 and Gold network RFM.

Sabot replaces Frédéric Schlesinger who has been appointed president of Lagardère Active's Groupe MCM, which includes the company's music TV channels MCM, MCM2, MCMA, MCM Belgique and Muzzik.

In addition, Jean-Pierre Ozannat, chief executive of Lagardère Media's radio and TV division Lagardère

Active Broadcast, is leaving the company "to pursue the development of personal projects". As a result, Lagardère Media president and CEO Arnaud Lagardère will now assume direct command of the division.



Sabot

Sabot joins a group which has suffered some disappointing ratings in recent months, with both Europe 2 and RFM underperforming. Sabot will report directly to Arnaud Lagardère. Sabot, who joined on November 13, will first concentrate on RFM, which will be "re-positioned" in the coming weeks.

At Lagardère, Sabot will be re-acquainted with several radio executives he knew from his NRJ days, such as Europe 2 programme director Sébastien Cauet, artistic director Didier Bouchend'homme, and marketing manager Henri-Paul Roy.

Visionary Acker loses battle with cancer

PARIS — One of Europe's radio "visionaries" Jean-François Acker died on November 8 aged 53 following a battle with cancer.

Acker had been the programme director of France's international radio service RFI since February 1999.

He was born in Colmar near the German and Swiss borders and started his career at Swiss public broadcasting corporation Radio et Télévision Suisse Romande, where he created and launched alternative station Couleur 3 in 1982. In 1986, after leaving TSR, he launched one of the first Swiss commercial stations Radio Lac, before entering into the world of TV production.

Acker resumed his radio career in 1990 when he joined Paris rock station OUI FM as programme director, and then in 1991 alternative station Radio Nova for two years. He then

went back to work for TV before joining RFI.

A funeral service was held in Paris on November 12, where tributes were paid by colleagues.

"He was someone who had 12,000 ideas a minute," recalls TSR's Thierry Catherine, who worked with Acker at Couleur 3. "He was never complacent, had incredible charisma, and an absolute-ly unique way of getting everyone on his side. At the same time he was very demanding—to himself and to the others—not necessarily someone easy to work with. The last time I saw him at RFI, instead of talking about market share, we talked about his projects—among other things, he wanted to create a show about dreams. He had a natural appetite for transgression. The little I know about radio, I owe to him."

Top of Pallain's hit list is Germany, which he claims "has decided to allocate its FM frequencies to local newspaper groups that have formed into a single sales house and who don't greet with much delight competition which, these days, is often symbolised by NRJ."

Pallain's comments struck a chord with Dominique Baudis, president of French media regulator the CSA, who admitted that "broadcasters should be able to operate throughout the whole European space," but added that one of the paradoxes of the EU is that while there is a very strong European legislation concerning TV, it is non-existent in radio. "Radio seems—wrongly—in the eyes of the European Commission to be a media which only has local relevance," said Baudis.

Repeating some of the points he made in an interview with M&M last week, Baudis claimed that there were some "discriminatory" licensing and frequency-allocation systems operating in European radio.

"It would be advisable for the European Union to act more strongly, so that the allocation of frequencies in a specific geographical zone should not be limited [to local operators], in order to make room for the arrival of some new operators."

Baudis also said that the EU should ensure that, to avoid dominant market positions, there should be pan-European ownership and cross-media rules. So far, this has not been necessary due to what Baudis describes as a "fragmented" market.

Baudis noted that radio and TV face a strong EU regulatory review in the coming years, with no less than six proposed Directives linked to electronic communication that will impact both industries.

"These proposals request a thorough review of the global regulatory framework in the broadcast field," warned Baudis, who invited radio broadcasters to "seize the opportunity of this technical, economic and regulatory convergence to fully become a part of 21st century media."

Paul Brown, chief executive of UK commercial radio trade body the CRCA, expressed his doubts about the prospect of additional European regulation. Brown said that the idea of a pan-European regulator is "something about which I have mixed feelings."

Pallain told M&M that pan-European regulation will not be contradictory to the preservation and respect of local cultures and identities. He added that his views don't mean the creation of another layer of regulation at a supra-national level, but rather a trimming down of the current layers of legislation and regulation that exist throughout European at a national level, in order to establish a truly level playing field. "Our goal is not more but less regulation, and certainly better regulation."

The **IFPI** is understood to have been given a mandate by its members to develop global marketshare information for the record industry. The first set of data will be compiled for 2001, based on manufacturers' net sales to the trade. The criteria being developed by **IFPI** would assign owned and licensed repertoire—but not distributed product—to a company for the purposes of share.

US radio group **Clear Channel** is understood to be planning expansion moves in Europe in the three main fields in which it operates: radio, outdoor advertising and concert promotion/venues. On the radio side, however, **Clear Channel's** non-EU status means it will be prohibited from owning majority stakes in broadcasters in many European countries.

French radio stations have paid a heavy price for their war coverage in Afghanistan. **RTL** reporter **Pierre Billaud** and his colleague from international news service **RFI** **Johanne Sutton** were both killed on November 11 following an ambush set up by **Taliban** forces.

The UK's **Capital Radio** group saw its profits fall by 27% to £30.1 million in the year ended September 30. Hitting **Capital's** profitability was a £1.5 million write off on international activities, including costs relating to "a potential acquisition opportunity in Europe," which M&M hears was Germany's Saxony-based **Hit Radio Antenne** group. Meanwhile, as expected **Scottish Radio Holdings** has completed a £36.4 million deal to buy the remaining 76% of Ireland's national Hot AC/talk station **Today FM** that it didn't already own.

Norway is set to host the opening night at **Midem 2002**, **Hotline** hears. About 20 Norwegian artists will be performing on two parallel stages and a separate Norwegian club night will also be organised.

Copenhagen and Barcelona are believed to be among the favourites to host the **MTV Europe Music Awards** in 2002. And the **NAB** has confirmed that its **European Radio Conference** in 2002 will be held in Prague.

As M&M was going to press, France's official **Médiamétrie** ratings for the September-October 2001 period showed that, as in Italy, stations with strong news content fared exceptionally well. However, music radio audiences generally held up post-September 11, with **Skyrock** and **Europe 2** recording gains.

Hotline hears that Norwegian public broadcaster **NRK** may have to make more staff cuts toward the end of the year, in addition to the 300 who have had to go in the last year. It is also rumoured that several of **NRK's** regional radio stations will be forced to merge.

Finally, the latest marketing brainwave from **Universal Music** sees US rock act **SUM 41** sponsoring Finnish ice hockey team **HIFK** (pictured). Ice hockey is Finland's most popular sport, and with the **SUM 41** logo proudly emblazoned on the team's jerseys, (pictured) a selection of songs from the band's album *All Killer, No Filler* will be heard blasting through the PA during **HIFK** home games.

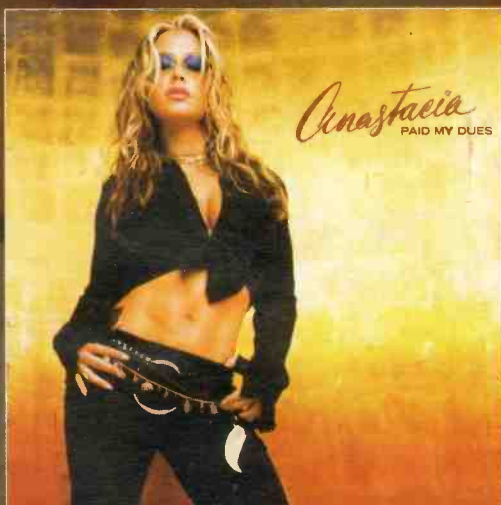

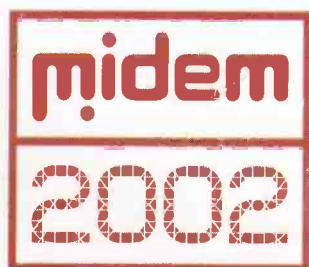
