## C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

C.1. Compliance with the Olympic Charter and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions).

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Olympic Charter, the World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of





Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the EOC and the rules of FIBA, may participate in the 2023 European Games.

#### C.2. Age requirements

To be eligible to participate in the European Games 2023, athletes must be born before 1 January 2005.

#### C.3. Additional FIBA requirements

To be eligible to participate in the European Games 2023, all athletes must have a confirmed account at <a href="https://play.fiba3x3.com">https://play.fiba3x3.com</a>.

Notwithstanding the above, to be eligible to participate in the European Games 2023, the athletes must comply with the specific nationality criteria for 3x3, as set out in the FIBA Internal Regulations, which are summarized below:

- They must hold legal nationality of the represented country;

- They must have presented a passport of the represented country;

- They cannot have played for the national team in basketball (5v5 or 3x3) for another country in an Official Competition of FIBA, except with a special dispensation from FIBA's Secretary General.

Only NOCs with National Associations which have not been the object of a suspension or otherwise sanctioned by FIBA are eligible to participate in the European Games 2023

#### D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

The qualification system allows for the participation of the best athletes through a fair and transparent process within the framework of the Olympic Charter.

#### D.1. Qualification Places

## E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

On 4 November 2022, the EOC, in the agreement with FIBA will inform NOCs, in writing, of the quota places they have obtained via Ranking List.

By 11 November 2022, eligible NOCs must inform the EOC, in writing, whether or not they intend to use the allocated quota places and participate in the 2023 European Games.

By 18 November 2022, all available quota places will be reallocated.

### F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

Any quota place declined or not confirmed by the NOC will be reallocated to the next highest ranked and eligible NOC, not yet qualified in the respective gender.

### G. QUALIFICATION TIMELINE

4 November 2022	The EOC, in agreement with FIBA, confirms in writing to NOCs the quota places obtained
11 November 2022	NOCs to confirm or decline the allocated quota places to the EOC
18 November 2022	The EOC, in agreement with FIBA to reallocate any unused quota places.
2 June 2023	European Games 2023 Sport Entries Deadline
21 June - 2 July 2023	European Games 2023

### H. OLYMPIC GAMES PARIS 2024 QUALIFICATION

As a FIBA 3x3 Recognised National Team Competition, the European Games 2023 will award ranking points counted towards the 3x3 Federation Ranking list for Paris 2024 qualification.
