Was born on 17 of June 1969 in Kaunas, Lithuania, where spend all his years of childhood and early younghood and complete secondary school. After the one year studies in Leningrad (today St. Petersburg) High marine engineering school (ship mechanic speciality) and 14 month of military service (infantry, reconnaissance troops, Ural and East Germany), in time of Lithuanian revolution and movement of independence come back to Lithuania and begin to work in Vytautas Magnus military museum, aviation department, after some month independent Lithuanian Aviation museum as restaurateur of the pre war and Soviet time aviation models.

From 1990 begin studies in Vytautas Magnus university in Kaunas, new established american style university (VDU), in department of humanity sciences, history. In 1994 get bachelor degree, Lithuanian history, bachelor work „Lithuanian Grand duchy army in 1764-1794“. 1994 - 1996 studied in master program of the same institution and the same time work in Vytautas Magnus military museum, department of Lithuanian Grand Duchy military history. In 1996 - master degree. Masters work: "Reforms of Lithuanian Grand Duchy army 1764 -1788“. In the same 1996 begin studies in doctor studies program in the same university, and work in university as assistant and the samee time in Lithuania military academy (later General Jonas Žemaitis Lithuanian military academy) as lector and instructor for military history in academic and military departments. From 1998 was nominated as chief of Vytautas Magnus Lithuanian military museum department of Lithuanian Grand Duchy military history. In 2000 successfully completed studies and defended dissertation "Army of Lithuanian Grand Duchy army in time of Four Year seym 1788-1792“ get Humanity science doctor scientific degree. It was the first doctor dissertation of military history in Lithuania. All time of studies was active member and leader of Lithuanian scouting organization and active member of history/humanity students organizations. These time begin to interest in fortification, studing additionally European architecture history (prof. E Levandauskas), written work "S. Vauban systems of fortification", preparing materials, constructing fortress models (XVII century Biržai fortress model, still presented in Biržai fortress museum, XIV c. Kaunas castle siege model in Vytautas Magnus military museum), consulting other models masters works, organizing student trips and scientific expeditions in field.

From 2000 begin active organization work in professional military history field. In 2000-2003 was elected as Lithuanian military history society president, From 2002 VDU and LKA military history center director. The same time work as lector, late as docent in Vytautas Magnus university and Lithuanian military academy, have possibility to lead bachelor, master works, participate in doctor studies process. As director of military history center begin to lead scientific and applicable projects, one from which: EU Interreg III B project „Baltic culture and tourism route (BFR)“, which played important role for the interest in fortress research field. In this project was responsible for partners work of Vytautas Magnus university and was elected as assistant leader of 1 working group (documentation and inventorisation) and later as leader of this working group and have possibility to get knowledge and praxis of organization of fortress organizations in Europe, especially in Germany, Poland, Latvia, Estonia, Netherlands. The same time national fortress research projects were provided: 1915-1918 East front fortification line, 1940-1941 Soviet „New border defense line (Molotov line)“ inventorisation project scientific leader. New projects, center of Fortress documentation and inventorisation studies, Society of Kaunas fortress were established. Because of changes in university leadership, in 2009 military history center and some other initiatives were closed. From this society of Kaunas fortress (Valdas Rakutis as president of association) are still acting and played important role in Kaunas fortress heritage research and preservation process as full member of non government organization Kaunas fortress projects.

2009-2014 work in General Jonas Žemaitis Lithuanian military academy as vicerector for studies and research. Military science institute was established, international cooperation, including with Warsaw Military university (Akademia Obrony Narodowej), Warsaw university were moved forward. From 2012 professor, „Journal of security and sustainability issues“ editor in chief, member of Wrocław Land forces military academy magazine „Zeszyty naukowe“ redcolegium, member of Lithuanian military history scientific magazine „Karo archyvas“ redcolegium, institute of military sciences military science board member. 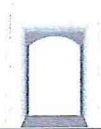

I would like to express my motivation as a candidate for the board. In this mail you receive my motivation for this function.

In our collaboration through EFFORTS we look at the importance of forts in European context. In this context we explore what forts can mean for society, how we can strengthen the presence of it and how we can come to unorthodox developments of the forts.
