**Decision:** Stop & Go Penalty

**Reason:**

After having received several warnings and the Black & White flag and a Drive Through Penalty the driver continued abusing the track limits.

Time penalties can only be served after they have been announced by the Race Director.

Once the Stop & Go /Drive-Through has been notified on the monitors, the car cannot cross the Line more than four times, except if provided under these Regulations.

Competitors are reminded that, in accordance with Art. 12.3.4 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Art. 16.2.6 of 2023 WEC Sporting Regulations this decision is not subject to appeal.
