

Radio Explosion Changes German Market

Future Of TV Pop Shows Uncertain

by Cathy Inglis

Hamburg/Munich/Cologne- The current explosion of new radio stations in Germany is drastically changing the radio and record market. The present success in northern Germany of Radio Schleswig Holstein (RSH) (winning more than 40% of the listeners from NDR) and the addition of two other strong radios in the area, Radio Hamburg and FFM in Hanover, has not only broken the monopoly of NDR, but is also triggering off a number of changes in personnel.

At the same time the major FM stations in Bavaria, in existence for over a year now, continue to draw listeners away from BR. Over the next six months more than 30 new radios may emerge and this figure could rise to around 80 by the end of 1987. These will cover the whole German territory with the exception of the West and Berlin federal states which are both under socialist councils, a factor

which tends to slow down new media explosions. Most of the new private stations are backed financially by media conglomerates like Springer and Bauer.

The established stations are feel-

ing the pinch and rumours continue that they are changing their formats in order to play more music as well. Although there is a strong likelihood that they will regain some of their lost

Supertramp Compilation Gets Euro-push

The European marketing push on the A&M Supertramp hit compilation album, "The Autobiography Of Supertramp" kicks off in Britain on October 12th with a series of 10 and 30-second TV commercials in the Granada region in the North, followed three weeks later by wide regional campaigns.

The television commercial was made by leading production house Limeight which incorporated live action footage based around Supertramp's album sleeves, now regarded as classics of graphic design. Although continental Europe will not do television advertising, extensive dealer campaigns will be set up backed up by in-store displays, includ-

ing a giant full colour cut-out of the new sleeve, streamer and posters. The album contains 11 of the band's major hits, compiled through an extensive market research. The cassette and compact disc versions contain three extra tracks. A double 'A' single from the album, "The Logical Song" and "Goodbye Stranger" was released by A&M last week. Together with the new Police album, "Every Breath You Take," The Singles, it will be A&M's most important release of the autumn.

Since signing to A&M 16 years ago, the band has released nine albums. The band is currently writing tracks for a new studio album which will be released early 1987.

SSS Concert Merges Live TV With Music

Sigue Sigue Sputnik promise "not just a concert, more an event" for the band's appearance at the Royal Albert Hall in London on October 13th. Tom James, manager/apokesman, says it will be the first time that rock 'n' roll and video have merged in a live situation.

He adds: "It's going to be like watching live television interlocking off the music. We've always said we'd do it, and now we will."

There will be massive video screens around the hall, some suspended from the ceiling. Via a huge satellite dish outside the hall, Sputnik technicians will pick up television material from all round the world and then feed in video footage of Sigue Sigue Sputnik performances, or live

television from, say, Moscow, or coverage of what is actually happening at the gig.

Says James: "The sound of that selected television will be part of the Sputnik music. There will be video monitors alongside the sound monitors at the front of the stage so we'll be interacting with what comes over on the screens. In addition, there will be Rollerball-lookies roller skating in and out of the audience."

The gig is set to be shown live throughout Europe on 'Music Box', and MTV in the States is virtually certain to show sections of a live in North America.

"The most electric and electrifying event of the pop year," says the controversial James.

Finnish Indie Radios Compete

After operating for a little over a year, the two independent commercial radio stations in Helsinki, Finland, are running neck-and-neck in terms of listener ratings.

Radio City emerges the more popular in the 12-34 age bracket, with its rock-orientated ad-lib style of programming, whereas Radio Etian is having the better of the ratings with older listeners, with a format of easy listening. Top 40 and chart. But Radio Etian is planning an injection of more rock to re-heat the ratings battle.

Financially, both stations spent their first year in the red, through insufficient advertising revenue and unexpectedly high running costs. But business is reported to have improved greatly during the summer months.

Italian Panarecord Pacts With CBS Fox New Deal Tackles Slow Video Market

With private television so much a dominant force nationwide in Italy, the country's video market has made slower progress than most other pan-European regions in the past few years.

But according to trade organization Univideo, pre-recorded video sales in Italy in 1985 totalled nearly 370,000 units, while in the first six months of 1986 alone they neared 475,000 units. The forecast for the July-December half-year is sales of more than 600,000 units.

In this setting, Italian record company Panarecord has built its home video market interest by signing a

license deal with CBS/Fox, following its previous pact with MGM/UA. The company claimed a 13% market share in the last quarter of 1985 and looks for better than 20% over this year as a whole.

While home video currently accounts for 85% of Panarecord's turnover, company president Sergio De Gennaro is now seeking increased action to rebuild the group's reputation as a leading independent record operator. He admits neglecting the audio side recently to create the right corporate structure to crack the slowly-emergent video industry.

TV5 Agrees Finnish Copyright Deal

French satellite service TV5 is to pay \$400 dollars in Finnish copyright bureau TEOSTO for music used in programmes broadcast to Finland during 1986. The deal is the first of a series of pending agreements with Scandinavian countries.

TV5 director general Paul Peyre and TEOSTO head Pekka Kallio negotiated the settlement, which is based on the 55,000 households currently receiving the service in Finland. The tariff is around 25% higher than that applying in other parts of Europe.

Similar deals with Denmark and Norway are reportedly close to completion.

German Vid Market Faces Piracy Boom

West German video firms are facing a new upsurge of piracy. Copyright society GVL says the industry is now losing 200 million dollars a year, despite increased efforts by police and GVL investigators which have led to nearly 500 criminal actions this year alone.

Illegal copies made by local pirates pose an additional problem. GVL estimates there are now up to 1,000 neighbourhood video libraries in West Germany, most of them based in the urban industrial areas. Copies made from stolen film prints appear on the black market within days, and may sell thousands of units at up to 75 dollars apiece.

With an official six month window between theatrical and video releases, and clear evidence that pirates are linked to organised crime, the most severe penalty handed down to date has been a 21 month suspended sentence. Most offenders receive fines which are far too small to act as a deterrent: one was caught again only

The The's Infected Album Guarantees Major Media Buzz

Johnson's Cinematic Views Shift Away From Usual Pop Imagery

The release of The The's second LP "Infected", the follow up to 1983's "Soul Mining", may well lead to some controversy, due to the unusual videos that will accompany all 8 tracks of the album. Shot in various locations all over the world like Peru, New York, Bolivia and Istanbul, the video images are quite explicit and radical in content. The The's sole member, Matt Johnson, has a powerful statement to make and his cinematic views are expressing his uncompromising and rebellious nature. Filmed by a team of directors, Tim Pope, Mark Romanek and Peter Christopherson, the swirling and powerful images depict the state of the human condition and civilization in all its aspects. Not traditional pop video imagery, but raw and naked shots with an overwhelming sense of realism. Sometimes violent, shattering and shocking, but always in line with his bitter and cynical lyrics. "The result is absolutely stunning," says Andy Frain, product manager of Epic. "Although it certainly won't be shown on children's TV, it

sound like a Walt Disney record," commented Andy Stevens, CBS head of International. "There is a real progression in his works and the album sounds more mature than ever", continues Stevens.

Much of the sales of the first album (250,000 copies worldwide) were in part achieved by word of mouth, as Matt Johnson is keen on keeping a low profile. The new LP is already guaranteed of much publicity and it will go silver when it is released, as pre-orders have already exceeded 60,000.

Somehow Matt Johnson automatically gets media coverage these days. The release of his first single for 3 years, Sweet Bird Of Truth, was a cause of some controversy between CBS and Johnson. The lyrics, about the thoughts of a US pilot as he is shot down over Arab territory (the song was actually written before the US bomb attacks on Libya), led CBS to believe it was better not to release the single. It was consequently deleted by CBS the day it was released (and





definitely puts a strong message across. It is music and visuals for adults and the two go amazingly well together."

Musically speaking, Matt Johnson has grown over the years. His voice is blunter than ever and the melodic touch of "Soul Mining" has shifted towards a more raw and pure sound. Pure emotion is at the heart of everything Johnson does and the album is a direct reflection of that. "Listening to his new album makes the debut

these things go sold out within days. The follow-up, Heartland, aroused a similar reaction as the BBC was not



too happy about the use of the word "Piss" and consequently, banned it from its playlists. Despite that, the single was a success, and reached the Top 30 in the UK.

With the "Infected" album scheduled to arrive mid to end of October on Some Bizarre/Epic, the full length video will be simultaneously released with a book, the compact disc and music cassette. The 8-track video will be a long-form video and is over 40 minutes in length.

Epic is organising major music press advertising plus inserts in Time Out and The Face. The inserts comprise 4-page booklets in a deluxe package with stills from the video and

brief explanations about the idea behind them. "We have to get people interested in what Matt has to say. We will organize a huge media event, preferably in a disused warehouse where the full length video will be shown on a 18 foot screen", Andy Frain added. Apart from a national flyposting campaign, Epic will link up a phone line with British Telecom where people will be able to hear short excerpts of the new LP.

Epic seems determined to get the masses aware of Matt Johnson's message. "The album is a statement and our whole campaign is aimed at getting people talking about it", concludes Andy Frain.



Bon Jovi Cross Into Mainstream Market

Phonogram Act Attracts New Fans

On August 18th Bon Jovi's third album "Slippery When Wet" hit the stores in the USA. Less than a month later it was certified platinum for sales of more than one million copies. PolyGram America's executive Vice President International Steve Pritchett expects to reach the no. 1 spot in the Billboard Album Charts within a few weeks, with sales surpassing the 2 million mark well before Christmas. "In other words", Pritchett enthuses, "this is a monster record."

Although it sometimes looks like hard rock bands can only achieve popular 'crossover' success in the States, Bon Jovi's story in Europe is also one of amazing success. "You Give Love A Bad Name", the first single of "Slippery When Wet", reached no. 14 in the UK, catapulting the album into the Top 10. Phonogram UK originally thought to sell 60,000 albums in the first three months of its release. As this figure has nearly been reached after only two weeks, product manager Dave Thorne had to adjust his expectations drastically. "It's a triumph of artistry", Thorne says about the collection of ten hard rocking songs on "Slippery When Wet". "Bon Jovi have the ability to play extremely well and write very good songs. There's a lot of heavy metal bands out there and people tend to

think they all sound the same, but Bon Jovi have the ability to be different, and find a whole lot of new fans that might not usually be interested in hard rock, without alienating the true heavy metal fan."

Bon Jovi used the massive 'Monsters Of Rock' festivals in Nuremberg and Mannheim, August 30th and 31st, to make their mark in continental Europe. Phonogram International flew in record company and media people from all over Europe to showcase Warlock, Def Leppard, new signing The Scorpions, and their priority act Bon Jovi. Since then, things have gone very smoothly for the band. Going to press, the lp was 26 in the European Hot 100 Albums with good positions in the UK, Germany, Switzerland, Sweden and Finland. Phonogram Germany, obviously most affected by the 'Monsters Of Rock' concerts, surpassed after four weeks the original three-month sales expectations of 45,000. A remarkable result considering Bon Jovi's previous album '7800 Fahrenheit', that has so far sold just 35,000 copies in Germany.

Bon Jovi is currently touring the States, and will return to take the UK in November - where all dates have already sold out, some in as short a time as six hours. A tour of the major cities in continental Europe is currently in



the works.

Phonogram International product manager Robbe Dennis is quite adamant about the success of his act: "As Bon Jovi is one of our priority acts, all of us are happy to give this project just that extra little push that will help make the record go the dis-

tance in virtually all the territories where it has been released. There is no doubt in my mind that Bon Jovi, through the sheer strength of their songs and musicianship, have crossed over from the rock/heavy metal market into a mainstream act."

Tom Robinson Displays Variety Of Styles



Over the years Tom Robinson has grown into a confident performer and all-round media personality. Trying to get away from the usual images of today's popstars, Robinson concentrated on a broader profile, supporting left wing causes and getting involved in various media events. His recent works for the BBC are a further proof of that. For several weeks he ran a series for the BBC World Service, a

weekly 15-minute show, presenting new and up-coming acts. Starting October 13, he will host the Janice Long show on BBC Radio One.

Emerging in the punk/new wave scene of '76, he scored his first hits under the banner of the Tom Robinson Band with his self-composed songs like "2-4-8-8 Motorway", "Don't Take No For An Answer" and later, under his own name, "War Baby"

and 'Listen To The Radio: Atmospherics'. His latest single for RCA, "Nothing Like The Real Thing", was a firm statement against cocaine entwined in driving and demanding funk rhythms ("Well it ain't as sweet, as people say. You are up all night, but you are down all day").

The single is featured on his second album for RCA, "Still Loving You", the follow-up to 1984's "Hope And Glory". With the exception of two co-productions with Steve Jolley, all material was produced by Tom in his own in-house 24-track studio. Musically speaking, the album has a broad range of different styles, while the lyrics

reflect his experiences while travelling through Europe.

"Three tracks on the album ('Feels So Good/Hurt So Bad', 'Still Loving You' and 'Spain') have been linked up in theme to form a concept video", says Peter Robinson (no relation), director A&R and marketing for RCA UK, "to show Tom as an album artist, primarily aiming to reach the older album buyer. In all respects Tom has matured as a recording artist and his new album is of much broader content than his previous one. We anticipate strong interest from CD sales", continues Robinson.

Other bodies for Nik Kershaw (new single Nobody Knows), Moroccan princess Stephanie with yet another bilingual single, Faith+One/ Love To Give and the (Times) Social Club with the Sep-1960s remixed dance hit Rumors.

British band Wang Chung deliver their best shot to follow up the 'Dance Hall Days' fame with yet another bilingual single 'Everybody Have Fun Tonight.' As the title implies lots of partying atmosphere. Cool And The Gang tells and introducing a new slogan: 'Everybody Have Wang Chung Tonight.'

After a long spell, American rock Eddie Money returns with a new single, 'Ike Me Home Tonight' featuring the guest vocals of Ronnie 'Be My Baby' Specter. It is an excellent solid rock tune in a fresh production by Eddie and Richie Zito who should bring Eddie Money back on the map.

While Huey Lewis remain 'Stuck' at the no. 1 in Billboard's Hot 100, they also continue to be the

favourites on European radio with their single Stuck With You for the fourth consecutive week no. 1. Tina moves up to no. 2 with a bullet and other fast movers in the top 10 include Commodores, Human League, Madonna's True Blue (in two weeks from 24 to no. 7), OMD and Paul Simon's You Can Call Me Al which is suddenly, after its re-entry two weeks ago, picking up huge European airplay.

Coinciding with their 25th anniversary, the Beach Boys release a new Capitol single, California Dreamin'. The group's rendition of the Man's & The Paps's 1966 hit features a wonderful 12-string guitar by Byrds' founder Roger McGuinn and the usual irresistible majesty of the vocal harmonies. Reserves to do very well.

With Holiday Rap sticking at no. 1 in the Hot

100 for the 3rd week, it is striking to see two other continental acts moving into Top 10 Swedish rock band Europe jump from 10 to 6 with The Final Countdown and Italian singer Spagna enjoys success with Easy Lady shooting up from 19 to 9 to renewed interest from Germany (making it the best selling Italian production of this year). Madonna has, as always, highest entry in the Hot 100 this week with True Blue debuting at no. 16. It is Madonna's highest entry this year as 'Live To Tell' and 'Papa Don't Preach' entered 18 and 24 respectively.

We are glad to see Motown releasing Lionel Richie's Love Will Conquer All. We always thought this single to be the best track on the 'Dancing On The Ceiling' album and many of our correspondents shared our view.

Check out M&M's New Talent tip of last week, Mike Maren whose disco song *Love Spy* is Top 20 in Germany at the moment. It is a rather straight forward electro tune with lots of synth effects that first broke in the German discotubes before entering the national pop charts.

GODFATHER'S GRAVITY

James Brown is undoubtedly one of the most successful black entertainers of the last 25 years; over 100 recordings for five different labels and making a glorious return last year with the Rocky IV track 'Living In America'. His new album for Scotti Bros, *Gravity*, marks another successful chapter in Brown's career. With the title track already on its way to become a favouritc on European radio, the Godfather's familiar brand of hot 'n' hard funk gets an eighties styling by Dan Hartman in *Let's Get Personal* (co-written) by Alison Moyet who can also be heard on the backing vocals), *Turn Me Loose*, *I'm Dr. Feelgood* and *Goliath*.

Miles Davis is one of the most influential jazz musicians of the last 25 years who started recording with CBS in 1957 and since then released some 30 albums as well as 4 compilations. He has shaped the course of modern music with albums like 'In A Silent Way' and 'Bitches Brew', by many regarded as the first and 'successful' attempts of jazz with rock. Since then, his way of working has become more and more eclectic, mixing African roots with rock and jazz as well as covering pop singles, like last year's 'Time After Time' (Cyndi Lauper) and Michael Jackson's 'Human Nature'. After recording for nearly 20 years for CBS, Davis suddenly switches to Warner Brothers for a new album entitled *Tutu*. The album features eight instruments, mostly funky and jazz-rock themes plus one cover of a pop song. Scritti Politti's *Perfect Day*. Other recommended tracks include *Don't Lete Your Mind* and the moody *Paria*.

Miami Vice star **Don Johnson** tries his hands at a musical career and, what nobody honestly expected, not without success. On his debut for Epic Johnson surrounds himself with musicians like

Ron Wood, Stevie Ray Vaughan, Willie Nelson and Bonnie Raiti. Johnson has a distinctive voice that, coupled with his enormous popularity as a tv personality can make the album a big seller. The first single from the album, the title track, is already picking up very encouraging reports from our correspondents and with other airplay candidates include *Voice On A Hotline*, *Love Routine* and *Heartache Away*.

Ex-Culture Club singer **Ruby Turner** picked up good media reactions on her debut single *If You're Ready, Come With Me*, although it failed to make real impact chartwise. The latter single is included on her live debut *Woman Held Up Hell The Sky* and labelsmate Billy Ocean and Jonathan Butler share the production credits together with John Astrop, Brian 'Chuck' New and Wornack & Wornack. With most of the material rooted in mainstream sound, tinged with gospel and reggae influences, Ruby's soulful and warm voice shines best in *Only Woman Bleed*, *Still On My Mind* (with an intro almost exactly that of Lou Reed's *Walk On The Wild Side*) and the Patti Labelle-ish *In My Life*.


English duo **It's Immaterial** follow up their UK top 10 hit *Driving Away From Home* with a debut album for Siren, entitled *Life's Hard And Then You Die*. The enigmatic duo display an amalgam of styles that defy classification. Intriguing songs floating from arty folk, atmospheric pop and jazz arrangements. 
