

TAKE A BIKE RIDE.

To discover the extinct animals of the Causses du Quercy.

In the villages of the Causse de Limogne (CONCOTS, BACH, ESCAMPS, CRÉGOLS, VAYLATS, LARNAGOL, LIMOGNE-EN-QUERCY), strange creatures from distant ages have reappeared.

These are sculptures of extinct animals whose fossils have been found in the phosphorites caves. They are the pride of the Causses du Quercy UNESCO World Geopark. Come and meet them on a bike tour featuring a series of riddles!

TIME TO PLAY!

In order to find the sculptures in each of the villages on the circuit, you'll need to solve the following riddles.

- CONCOTS

They call me *Peratherium lavergnense*. I watch over this place by day, and at night I keep watching to ensure the safety of whoever's working before everyone else gets up. You can find out where I am using this riddle.

- I'm the first store open in the morning, and the busiest during breakfast and lunch breaks.
- Famous around the world, I'm home to one of France's best-known symbols.
- I'm the landmark of gourmands and bon vivants, who am I?

ESCAMPS

Do you know the Grande Sompe d'Escamps? It's a place that brings together several elements of traditional local life: a pond, a washhouse, a well and a water trough. I chose this place to drink. My name is *Palaeotodus escampiensis*. To be able to find me, I'd have told you to spread your wings. Instead you have no choice but to follow the road and the "senteur du Quercy".

Before you reach the town hall, take the D22 "ROUTE DE LA CALOUSSADE" on your right, whistling a tune of your choice, and I'll appear before your eyes.

BACH

My name is *Bachiterium* guirounetensis. Decipher this rebus to find me.














CREGOLS

I'm Vaylatsia cregolensis. Although few people know my complicated name, other current species look like me and are well known. Love me or hate me, I'm an animal with many senses. I fly with my hands, thanks to my extended fingers. I see and hunt with my ears. I hibernate in winter and sleep upside down. I like the night, but a very dark night.

In Crégols, however, I'M ILLUMINATED BY A STREET LAMP. If you can't see me, do as I do and look to the stars!



LIMOGNE-EN-QUERCY

They call me *Limognitherium*. My nickname is "the gorilla-horse" because of my distinctive gait. My front-limbs are longer than my hind-legs and I walk on my knuckles, like a gorilla. I can also stand on my hind legs to reach high leaves.
