'Conservative' stations face chart downgrade

HAMBURG — German radio stations which do not play a sufficiently wide variety of new releases will have their weighting downgraded in the compilation of Germany's official Media Control singles chart, which has a significant airplay component.

The official warning was issued via a December 1 statement from

the German Federal Association of the Phonographic Industry (BPW), and comes two months after representatives from Germany's commercial radio association VPRT, at a meeting with the BPW's marketing committee in October, agreed to consider playing more new releases during peak daytime programming.

Tim Renner, president of Music at Universal Music Germany, denies

Another Sash! hit for trance-pop

LONDON — The DJ who helped to turn European trance-pop into a red-hot commodity is back on the air and the dancefloors *encore une fois*.

Sash!, the German artist signed internationally to X-IT/edel and in the UK to Multiply, is returning to international pop playlists with his new, Spanish-flavoured single *Adelante*, released in most of Europe on November 22 and on December 6 in Germany, with a UK appearance currently set for January 31. His new album, *Trilenium*, is also planned for early 2000.

The single, which appropriately translates as "ahead" or "go forward," follows the extraordinary success of Sash!'s two albums to date, 1997's *It's My Life* and last year's *Life Goes On*. Between them, they brought forth huge hits while making Sash! the toast of pop clubs and paving the way for subsequent crossovers by the likes of ATB, DJ Jurgen featuring Alice DeeJay and DJ Jean.

So can the Cologne-based producer-DJ keep up the momentum

generated by such party pieces as *Encore Une Fois*, *Ecuador* and *Stay* in '97 and *La Primavera*, *Mysterious Times* and *Move Mania* in '98? If the comments of programmers like Pascal Remy at Paris dance station Voltage FM are a yardstick, the

answer is yes.

"It's a solid, well produced pop record," says Remy. "Like all Sash! tunes there is a rich sound that is different to other records in [this] style. It's obvious that he's a DJ by the way he produces: the sounds are balanced and well organised."

Duroux exits CLT in France

PARIS — In a surprise move, Axel Duroux has announced his resignation as president of CLT-UFA French networks CHR Fun Radio and AC RTL2.

Duroux will quit the company at the end of January 2000 to join Dutch group Endemol, where he will be in charge of TV and multimedia developments.

Duroux says that he is leaving "for personal reasons" and he feels "it's the right time." He adds: "I wanted to get into a new venture and the radio business is pretty small—there aren't that many opportunities to progress."

However, Duroux says there couldn't be a better time to depart, as he feels he has fulfilled his goals at CLT-UFA. "During the five

Upfront

So, there has been a major UK radio conspiracy against Cliff Richard.

The ageing rocker, whose single *The Millennium Prayer* (on the Chrysalis Group's new label Papillon) went to No.1 last week in the UK sales charts after an initial entry at number 2, achieved this rare feat without any radio support. Nationwide airplay tracking shows the song earned 22 spins before it charted, and not many more the week after (not even at Chrysalis' own Heart FM stations!).

Hence this great claim from Richard and his spin doctors—the song is banned on radio but endorsed by the public, so how come stations, especially “public” ones, are not playing what the public wants?

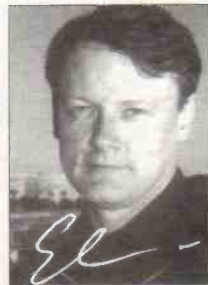
Well, programmers throughout the UK individually made a decision not to play the track, just as they do with

over 98% of the songs that they get sent. There is no blanket “ban” as Richard suggests—reasons for not playing the song can vary from one station to another: naff song; singer out of tune with the station's demographics; image problems; format inconsistencies and so on.

All European countries have had, and will continue to have, Cliff-like songs selling by the bucketload at retail and by no means supported by radio. But no one pretends these songs are banned by radio stations—these things happen.

When you can't find a decent explanation, conspiracy theories are always a good bet—and the fantastic thing is that the UK media bought it! Well done Sir Cliff, what a great promotional coup.

And let's have a charitable thought for the poor guy at EMI who passed on the option to release the single—and who must have seen his Christmas bonus evaporate overnight.

Capital seeks new AC solutions

LONDON — The UK's Capital Radio Group has teamed up with strategic marketing consultancy New Solutions to come up with fresh new ideas for its national AC service, which will debut on Digital One's national digital multiplex early next year.

In the broadcasting sphere, New Solutions is best known for its work with BBC TV on its innovative animated series *Walking With Dinosaurs*.

Capital's head of adult brands Jeff O'Brien, who will be overseeing the programming of the as-yet-unnamed station, admits that, given the crowded nature of the AC market in the UK, “the big thing will be the style and attitude of the station—and that's what we're trying to find with them [New Solutions].”

According to O'Brien, the new station's music policy will be “pretty much inbetween” mainstream and soft AC, with a “slight” female bias. Under the terms of its contract with Digital One, Capital's new service

will be on the air by the end of January 2000, but initially the service will be mainly voice-tracked, with Paul Phear moving over from London CHR station 95.8 Capital FM as the only “live” presenter.

It is the second time Capital has enlisted the help of an outside company in developing its programming concepts—in 1998, it used Bob Geldof's production company Planet 24 for the relaunch of Alternative Rock station Xfm/London. Explains O'Brien: “Because we all get very close to the industry, you sometimes have to look outside that to get something else—it might be just one little idea which gives you the spark

to go onto something bigger. With the new millennium and digital radio, it's time to have a look outside for ideas that will evolve radio to the next step.”

Heading up Capital's digital programming overall will be Pete Simmons, who moves from programme controller of Capital FM to the post of programme controller, digital. Simmons says of his move: “This is a great opportunity to launch a national station, and it's exciting to move into the market of the future.”

No successor to Simmons has yet been appointed at Capital FM. Group programme director Richard Park will temporarily assume daily control of the station.

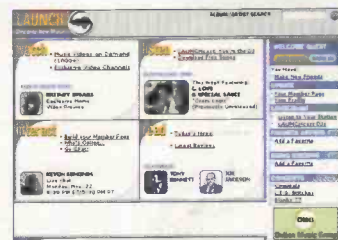

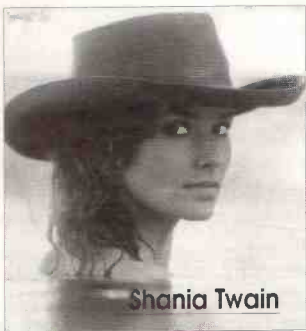

ON THE BEAT

COME ON OVER, TO MULTI-PLATINUM

LONDON — International music body IFPI has awarded Shania Twain's *Come on Over* (Universal) a multi-platinum Europe award for European sales topping four million in its latest accolades, which recognise sales up to the end of November. Céline Dion's *All The Way* (Sony), goes straight to double platinum, along with Ricky Martin's eponymous English language album (Sony). Travis receive their first ever IFPI Platinum Europe Award for *The Man Who* (Independiente), while Cher's *Greatest Hits* (Warner), Eric Clapton's *The Clapton Chronicles* (Warner), Mariah Carey's *Rainbow* (Sony), Sting's *Brand New Day* (Universal) and Texas' *The Hush* (Universal) also receive platinums.

EMI NORWAY REORGANISES

OSLO — EMI Norway has reorganised its local A&R department, naming Eivind Rølles, formerly head of A&R, as special marketing manager. He will not be replaced. Rølles will be responsible for catalogue exploitation and some of EMI's veteran domestic artists, including Jahn Teigen and Travelling Strawberries. Local A&R operations will be handled by Gry Zachariassen and freelancer Olle Løstegaard. Upcoming local releases include a solo album by Bel Canto vocalist Anneli Drecker and debut albums by rock bands Corvine and Atakama.

O'HARA SWAPS AIRE FOR ATLANTIC

DUBLIN — John O'Hara, formerly programme director for Emap-owned Aire FM, the Leeds-based CHR station, has started a new position as managing director of Irish-based CHR Atlantic 252, which transmits on AM throughout most of the UK. O'Hara has been given the green light by Atlantic 252's owners, CLT-UFA, to target new listeners and reverse the station's fortunes. He says: "Moving from local to national radio is a real challenge. Atlantic 252 is not the station that it was five years ago and it's my job to make sure that changes."

Succeeding Puhakka in his job is EMI Finland's marketing director, 32-year old Wemppa Koivumäki, who has overseen marketing operations for both Virgin's and EMI's local and international repertoire. He will report to Copenhagen-based EMI Music Scandinavia president Michael Ritto.

MTV GERMANY APPOINTS COMMUNICATIONS MANAGER

MUNICH — Angela Sebrich has been named communications manager for MTV Germany, effective January 2000. Sebrich, 33, has been head of press at commercial radio station Antenne Bayern for five years. Also part of the newly-formed communications team are Johannes Ganderberger, Mirja Bauer, Florian Breunig and Sabine Wendler.

Nordics Click2Music

OSLO — The Nordic affiliates of BMG are boosting their on-line presence with Click2Music, a joint venture designed to co-promote the company's Scandinavian and international artists. Click2Music is set to help Scandinavian artists across the region's borders.

Local sites have already launched in Sweden and Finland and are operated by existing staff at the BMG companies. The Norwegian site is active, but will not be properly launched until the new year. The Danish site is likely to be launched imminently.

BMG Netherlands is the only other affiliate in Europe to have joined the concept, which is primarily a joint venture between the Scandinavian BMG companies.

BMG in Germany and the UK operate their own promotional sites under different names, and sources suggest



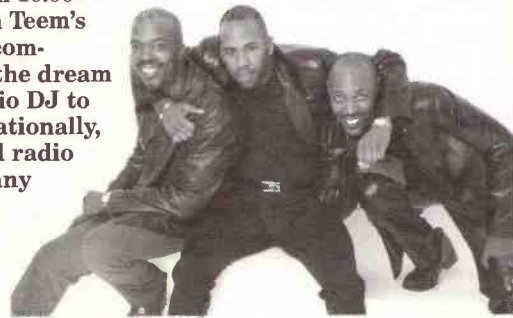
that there is dissent towards which name will ultimately be used.

The Nordic and Dutch initiative follows Universal/BMG's plans to launch its e-commerce operation Getmusic in the UK, Germany, France, and the

Netherlands. It's believed that Getmusic will roll out in several European markets next year.

BMG Sweden label manager Erik Lant says: "It's too early to say how it all will be organised. But we hope that Click2Music will be used as a brand in more European countries to create a comprehensive platform [for BMG artists]." The sites are managed by label manager Kimmo Valtanen in Finland, special marketing manager/Internet manager Thomas Larsen in Denmark, and Internet manager Henrik Njaa in Norway. Adds Lant: "The idea is that the daily updates will be conducted by internal staffers [who also hold other jobs within BMG], but as the site progresses, we will probably hire new people."

The Drem Teem, the UK garage DJs who recently revamped Neneh Cherry's *Buddy X*, are to host Sunday mornings on the UK's public CHR station, BBC Radio 1. The first show is scheduled for January 23 2000, and will run from 10.00-13.00. Drem Teem's DJ Spooky comments: "It's the dream of every radio DJ to broadcast nationally, and national radio doesn't get any bigger than Radio 1."



Grammy split at IFPI Denmark

COPENHAGEN — IFPI Denmark, the Danish arm of the international music body, has split its Dansk Grammy 2000 ceremony into three separate events for classical, jazz and pop/rock music at different venues on consecutive evenings.

"We will do a spectacular pop/rock show," says Jan Degner, chairman of the IFPI Grammy committee. "That means that different target groups won't be bored by things that aren't of interest."

"Most of the show will be broadcast live and I think dividing it up will benefit everyone," says Jesper Bay, MD of MusicMatters, the company arranging the gala event for IFPI.

The list of nominees in 25 pop/rock categories will be released shortly before Christmas. An academy established by IFPI will choose all nominees and 15 winners, while popular vote will be used for the 10 most popular categories.

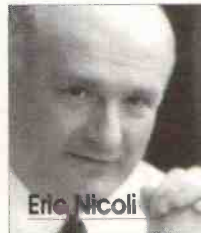
Awards for classical music will be given on February 3, with jazz awards on the following night. Both events will be broadcast on public broadcaster Danmarks Radio's classical/jazz station P2.

EMI sells its 13.3% GWR Group stake

LONDON — EMI has sold to institutional buyers its holding of 14.8 million shares (13.3%) in GWR, the radio group which owns Classic FM, at a price of 550p (euros 8.73). EMI bought the stake for £28.4m two years ago and has sold the shares for £80m, using the proceeds to repay borrowings, according to an official statement.

The sale follows the announcement of EMI's interim results last week which confirmed that EMI is looking to boost its new media activity (M&M, December 4). Eric Nicoli, EMI Group chairman, has said that he expects some 10% of revenue to be related to Internet businesses by 2005.

He comments in the statement: "Although the outlook for the radio industry in the UK remains positive and GWR is particularly well-positioned to compete effectively, especially in the digital arena, our shareholding did not fall within our strategy."

Jason Crisp, director of corporate affairs for EMI, says: "EMI is a focused music company and so it is a good time to dispose of interests that are peripheral to our main strategy."

Henry Meakin, chairman of GWR, comments: "EMI has been a supportive shareholder in recent years. However, we recognise that investment in the radio industry is not part of their strategy."

Dance grooves

BYRON TIME

The title is familiar, and indeed Byron Stingily's *That's The Way Love Is* (Nervous/US) is THAT track. Stingily is, as always, in fine, honeyed voice while a string section picks out the melody in a fittingly delicate manner. Brass parts add a bit o' rude to a track that, especially on the Rhythm Masters remix, is a serious crossover contender.

BLUE SKIES AHEAD

Following their splendid fourth album, *Suspicious* (Dorado/UK), and fresh from remix duties for Sly & Robbie, Outside have on *Blue Sky* undergone a bit of a change. Their new sound is bigger, deeper and altogether more introspective than previous outings. Appropriately, vocal duties this time are taken care of by ultra moody J.B. Eckls, ex-singer for Santana and War, while the music, dub heavy and shimmering, provides dreamy slabs of support. A beautiful song by any standards.

FOURTH TIME AROUND

Now on its fourth release, Golden Girls' *Kinetic* (distinctive/UK) is, given its classic status and the current chart hunger for all things trancy, fair game for a new set of mixes. Already on some 20 plus playlists in the UK, the track arrives with new mixes from Jenson & Carter, Trevor Nelson and Commie, of which Commie comes out on top. He also provides a neat "Remix Edit" which retains all the charm and melodic life of the original while adding a thoroughly contemporary angle that should see the track safely into the Christmas charts.

REIGN OF THE SUPAKINGS

Picked up on some weeks back by the underground community as being one of the most sizzlingly upful tracks of 1999's last quarter, The Supakings' *Back and Forth* (Diversion/Holland) is the sort of tune that radio will probably go for as well. Buckets of jazzy vocal action plus a thumping house beat and horns aplenty are the main ingredients. The rest is down to phat, highly animated production sound. A song which, despite that big production, recalls the rather more minimal Inner City spliced with Chic-esque trimmings.

ESSENTIAL ECLECTICISM

Although a relative newcomer to the scene, London-based Nuphonic has rapidly established itself as a label to be reckoned with at the jazzy end of the spectrum. The just-released label compilation *Nuphonic 02* is dominated by tracks which feature real instruments backed up by a minimum of technology. It is also a triumph of unpretentious good taste and clearheadedness. The result is music which is raw at heart but polished, pointed and strangely comforting in its own, edgy way. Take the cover of Talking Heads' *Born Under Punches* by Fuzz Against Junk. Alongside the impressive sound quality and the profound funkiness of the track, the twangy guitar parts are right on the money, a rare thing in the post-guitar era.

More surprises on set opener *Moving Cities* from Faze Action. This time a cello takes the lead to be joined by guitar, Rhodes and percussion. A spirited stab at neo-classical, post modernist funk, with undertones of Van Dyke Parks. Amongst the many standout moments, Roy Davis Jr.'s *Michael* is a bona fide nu soul classic.

Townshend's Lifehouse lives

Almost 30 years after it was written and abandoned, the missing link between the Who's

rock operas *Tommy* and *Quadrophenia* was finally due its first full airing on Sunday, December 5—as a narrative play on the BBC's classical network, Radio 3.

Lifehouse has long been regarded as the great "lost" Who project after it was aborted in 1971. Now it will receive multi-format exposure not only as a radio play but as

a book, an audio book, a six-CD box set and another limited edition box.

The two-hour radio production, starring Geraldine James and David Threlfall, forms part of *The Lifehouse Chronicles* box, released on Townshend's Eel Pie Records on December 6. The set also contains his original music for the project, including demos of such Who classics as *Baba O'Riley* and *Won't Get Fooled Again*, which surfaced later in 1971 on the album *Who's Next*.

The broadcast represents a coup for BBC Radio Productions and was directed by Kate Rowland, head of BBC radio drama. Co-production was by Tom Critchley for Eel Pie Productions. The original text has been modified by writer Jeff Young, but Townshend has been involved at every level, including rehearsing the cast.

"Radio is the best combination to focus on the vivid combination of words and music," says Townshend. "I became obsessed with telling the story behind my failure to complete what was genuinely a good idea." The play will be available as a double cassette through the

BBC Radio Collection and published in book form by Simon & Schuster. A second box set, *The Lifehouse Method*, will follow, limited to 2,001 copies and with an interactive element via a software "key."

Lifehouse was conceived as a feature film—Universal Pictures had pledged \$2 million—but never got further than two partial performances at London's Young Vic Theatre in early 1971. Its apocalyptic vision of a future in which human contact is possible only through a "vast global network" predicted the arrival of the Internet. "I feel sure it will be greeted as a contemporary classic," says Rowland. "It's extraordinary when you think about what he was writing in 1971. It was like he was projecting ahead. He was hitting the nail almost right on the head."

The appearance of *Lifehouse* comes at the busiest period of Who activity for many years. Townshend, Roger Daltrey and John Entwistle have played four US concerts in recent weeks, with a London gig mooted for the Teenage Cancer Trust, possibly before Christmas. There are also tentative plans for the band's first album of new material since *It's Hard* in 1982. "We each [overcame] a lot of personal pride to do these shows," says Townshend on his www.petetownshend.com website. "We are getting on well, we love each other."

On December 4, LWT was due to feature *Who's Next* in its Classic Albums series across the UK's ITV network, and on the 6th Polydor will reissue a digitally remastered version of that album with new notes by Townshend. In February, the Who will follow the precedent of the Beatles and Led Zeppelin with *The BBC Sessions*, featuring two dozen tracks recorded for various radio broadcasts between 1965 and 1972.

Arid landscape blooms

With sales in Belgium close to gold (25,000 units) and wider European release beckoning, Ghent-based rock quartet Arid's album *Little Things Of Venom* is not so little any more.

The band gained immediate recognition in 1996 as finalists in the Humos Rock Rally, organised by the TV and rock magazine. Their emotive, song-driven rock, featuring the distinctive timbre of singer-guitarist Jasper Steverlinck, secured a deal with the independent Double T Music and the album's release in April in Belgium, as well as Holland, Germany and France through Double T's Sony affiliates.

"From day one, we knew that Arid's live performances were [our] premier promotion tool," says Christophe Turcksin, co-managing director of Double T Music, "so we organised a number of showcases for local media, promoters and international Sony/SINE executives plus audiences from radio competitions. The positive buzz resulted in full houses."

In mid-March Arid's first single, *Too Late Tonight*, became an instant radio hit in

Belgium, not only with alternative stations but on commercial networks NRJ and Radio Contact and news-talk outlets such as Radiol.

"Initially we weren't too keen on playing Arid," admits VRT rock/alternative formatted Studio Brussel's producer Eddy Hendrix, "because we thought the music was somewhat 'overloaded.' But, having witnessed them as a live band, we are now convinced of Arid's talent."

At writing, the album had sold close to 35,000 units in the combined territories. In February, *Little Things of Venom* will be released in the rest of Europe and the US, where Arid signed to Columbia after being invited to perform two New York showcases for the label.

"We are very privileged to work [with] an independent company," says Steverlinck. "They're enthusiastic about what we do. I'm happy to see that big record business executives can be crushed between both fingers by true music that comes from the heart."

Arid will perform as openers for Suede this month in Utrecht, Rome, Milan, Barcelona and Madrid. Their European booking agents Primary Talent are scheduling a further support tour during the first months of 2000.

Album spotlight

GEORGE MICHAEL SONGS FROM THE LAST CENTURY

Virgin
International release date: December 6
Retailers will be looking to George Michael's new album of his favourite music to decorate their tills with tinsel, but the message from many radio programmers about its lead track (his interpretation of the Police's *Roxanne*) is that not even Michael can expect wall-to-wall airplay in such a restrained, cocktail-lounge mood. Pop radio has become more nervous than ever of records without a driving beat or big-ballad sentiment, and while Michael will certainly carry his fans with him regardless, many of them may find their local CHR outlet politely declining the record's charms. That said, *Songs From The Last Century* is a dream release for any AC station cultivating a sophisticated sound. It opens with *Brother Can You Spare A Dime*, performed at October's NetAid concert, and has a more well-rounded retrospective flavour than many other millennial projects, simply by acknowledging pop music of the pre-rock'n'roll era. Thus Michael tips his hat to Doris Day with a swingin' remake of the Calamity Jane smash *Secret Love* and dips in the Rodgers and Hart catalogue for *Where Or When*. Bolder still, he retools *I Remember You* (previously yodelled to number 1 by Frank Ifield in 1962, a year before George was born) as a pensive slowie with

harp accompaniment. A version of Bono and Co's 1995 hit *Miss Sarajevo* is the only track likely to get a shot at pop playlists, which says more about the commercially-driven inflexibility of the format than the élan of the album.

MIKE OLDFIELD THE MILLENNIUM BELL

Warner Music
International release date: November 29
They'll be swaying to this around midnight on December 31 in the streets of Berlin, where Oldfield will perform the album in a Millennium Eve concert. Not one to do things by halves, he is also pitching for a worldwide television audience of 200 million. It has long been de rigueur in his home country to deride such grand-scale showmanship, but Oldfield continues to be one of the UK's more prosperous exports. *The Millennium Bell* is his second album of 1999 and follows hard on the *Guitars* album and *Then And Now* tour which attracted European audiences totalling 350,000. The new set mounts a 2000-year voyage through musical history, embracing carols, orchestral epics and incantations, with the Grant Gospel and London Handel Choirs and the London Session Orchestra all enhancing the commemorative mood. The climax comes with the club-friendly title track, which at the end of the month will provide those millions with a contemporary alternative to *Auld Lang Syne*.

Dance Beat

The weekly dance chart comment by Harald Roth

The Wamdue Project's *King Of My Castle* (Strictly Rhythm) is probably one of THE success stories of the year. It seems that the track can't be stopped on its journey from territory to territory in Europe. Last on the block in the UK, the single made a smashing entry at the top of the CIN sales charts last week—a crowning moment for a title which has already spent no less than 50 weeks in the European Dance Traxx.

The irony is that the titled first appeared in the UK over 15 months ago in its original US, mixes and failed miserably. Come to think of it, it's quite remarkable that its rejuvenated lease of life is to the credit of Italian remixers who have turned the track into a catchy hit. While *King Of My Castle* is still high in the Dance Traxx, look for Wamdue's new track, *You're The Reason* (Strictly Rhythm), to move up the ladder from its debut this week at 80.

Elsewhere, there's plenty of life in Europe's dance charts this week and most of the action is due to girl power. Not content with the number 2 slot for the second week with *Better Off Alone*, Alice DeeJay manages to log a second title into the Top 20 with *Back In My Life* (Violent), which moves up to 16 from 35.

Ann Lee's *Voices* (X-Energy), a follow up to 2 *Times*, flies to 37 from 90, while Salomé de Bahia's *Outro Lugar* (Yellow) makes a superb entry in the Top 40 at 22 after just two weeks in the charts, with support in Germany, France and the UK.

Watch out also for Eiffel 65's sophomore *Move Your Body* (Skooby/Bliss Co.) to shake the upper reaches of the European Dance Traxx. The title is already receiving close attention in France and in Poland, and moves to 71 this week, up from...475. An early hit warning!

And for all those who are interested in statistics, one 1999 trend is clear: all the Dance Traxx No. 1s spent a minimum of 4 weeks at the top of the charts. The current No. 1, Bob Marley Vs. Funkstar Deluxe's *Sun Is Shining* (Hypnotic/edel), already 8 weeks in the top slot, is only three weeks away from equalling the longest running chart-topper on European Dance Traxx—Mousse T Vs. Hot'N'Juicy's *Horny '98* (Peppermint Jam)—and therefore to set a new longevity record for most weeks at No. 1 in the history of the chart.

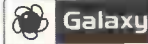

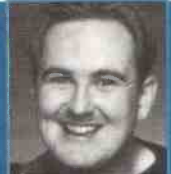

On the air

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

As this year, decade, century and millennium come to an end, European radio is nurturing diversity as never before. The European Radio Top 50 this week features veterans and teen queens, latin singers and ex-boyband stars as well as former Spice Girls. Jennifer Lopez' *Waiting For Tonight* (Work/Columbia) heads a top five which contains rock veteran Tina Turner, pop diva Céline Dion and golden boys Will Smith and Robbie Williams, all of whom have made their mark in the '90s.

While European radio still dedicates airtime to Christina Aguilera's massive hit *Genie In A Bottle*, at 10 this week, her new single, *What A Girl Wants*, (both RCA) is this week's highest new entry at 42. The 18-year-old's second track from her self-titled album is being picked up by radio stations in most of the European territories: Italy, Denmark, Belgium, Sweden, Germany and the UK. Jan van Hoorickx, head of music at Brussels CHR station VRT Radio Donna, sees Aguilera's new single as a no-brainer: "It's an obvious choice for our playlist because Christina Aguilera is a happening, up and coming artist. The track is similar to *Genie In A Bottle*, which we play as a recurrent, and it has a prosperous future in the Flanders charts and probably also in the French-speaking part of Belgium."

While most of Europe is busy going to Christmas parties and preparing for the festive season, Belgium is taken by a magic love story. Their prince Philip is to marry his Mathilde di Akoz on 4 December, providing the Belgians' last royal wedding this millennium. Universal Music Belgium is to release a compilation album on the day, entitled *Philip & Mathilde*, which is to include a special version of Eric Clapton's *Wonderful Tonight*, a tune Philip and Mathilde danced to at their engagement party at the Royal Palace in November. VRT Radio Donna is also involved in the wedding celebrations, as Jan van Hoorickx explains: "There is a lot of interest around the wedding, including among our listeners. Our regular Saturday programme, 'Fun Files,' will dedicate its full five hours on the big day to covering the event."

The Artist's new single, produced by Prince, *The Greatest Romance Ever Sold* (Arista), is also a new entry this week at 46. The track is taken from *Rave Un 2 The Joy Fantastic*, his first album on Arista, licensed from his own label New Power Generation Records. The album stayed in the European Top 100 Albums chart for only a couple of weeks.

However, if European radio programmers show interest in the ballad, it may give the album a second chance in time for Christmas. Another new entry is Swedish Andreas Johnson's *Glorious* at 48. The track is taken from Johnson's second album, *Liebling*, (both Metronome).

Britney Spears' *Born To Make You Happy* (Jive), Tom Jones & Mousse T.'s *Sex Bomb* (V2/Gut) and Roxette's *Salvation* (Roxette Recordings/EMI), all second or third releases from existing albums, may well be new entries in next week's chart.

S4 hits on local acts

MILAN — The new S4 label of Sony Music Entertainment Italy (SME Italy) will deal with local artists' releases from the group's continental European affiliates in Italy from January 1.

SME Italy occupied the top four positions of the Italian album charts compiled by AC Nielsen and local industry body FIMI for the week ending November 18, thanks to its acquisition of indie label RTI Records from media group Mediaset in July (M&M, July 24).

Renamed S4 on October 1 (as it is SME Italy's fourth record division after Columbia, Epic and Sony Music Classical), three of those top four chart positions were taken by artists distributed by the S4 label; Mina (PDU), Adriano Celentano (Clan) and 883 (FRI Records). The fourth Sony-distributed artist in the top four was Columbia's Claudio Baglione.

Carlo Mancini, programme director at Rome based AC network Radio Capital, says that the new S4 division will have their work cut out to maintain this level of success with domestic artists. "Between Epic and Columbia, Sony have a large repertoire of established Italian artists, while S4 have played all their aces, with the exception of Michele Zarillo."

"Never in the history of the Italian charts have the top four selling titles been from domestic artists all released by one company," claims SME Italy President Franco Cabrini adding, "this is thanks to our acquisition of RTI Records and the work of Roberto Magrini."

Roberto Magrini, managing director of S4 Records, comments: "The integration of RTI Records into Sony has been very positive. Working with Franco (Cabrini) and his team has overcome our main problem at Mediaset of having relatively little support. Within Sony we are creatively autonomous and are conditioned only by financial targets."

Magrini says that another advantage of belonging to SME

Italy is their imminent expansion into international repertoire. "From January 1 we are hoping that Italy will become a launch pad for these domestic acts in the rest of Europe. We will also continue to establish our own signings internationally."

Melodic pop singer/songwriter Michele Zarillo is S4's international

priority, while singers Adriano Celentano, Mina and rock group PFM are set for another push, initially in Europe and Latin America. Corrado Rustici, who produces the Mercury/Universal artist Zucchero, has been signed to produce PFM's new album. Magrini did not disclose the first European acts to be released by S4, but said they are SME artists signed in Denmark and Sweden.

Tiziano Baudo, responsible for rapport with record companies for Milan based CHR network RTL 102.5 Hit Radio maintains that S4 will be able to maintain consistent success with domestic repertoire. "I have closely followed Roberto Magrini's movements and saw his frustrations at RTI. With the backing of Sony we can see his label's potential emerging. The S4 artists Mina, Celentano and the Columbia artist Claudio Baglione might not be cutting edge acts, but they represent our cultural patrimony, artists that we have all grown up listening to," says Baudo.

In the FIMI/Nielsen album chart of the week ending November 25, SME Italy-distributed artists still occupied four of the top five positions. Adriano Celentano's album *Io Non So Palar D'Amore* (Clan/S4) has shipped 700,000 units during a chart run of 29 weeks according to label sources.

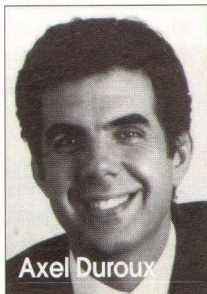
years I spent at RTL 2, turnover has increased fivefold, and Fun will break even this year," he says.

A colleague of Duroux says the announcement "was a complete surprise. The stations are doing well and there was no reason for him to leave."

A spokeswoman for Luxembourg-based CLT-UFA says the company is "disappointed" but adds: "We understand that for him, it was the right time to try something different. He's done a great job and we understand his decision, which is a personal one."

Declining to elaborate on Duroux's replacement, she says that

the situation is under review by CLT-UFA's executive vice president for radio Jean-Michel Kerdraon. Duroux says he will stay until the end of January in order to help the board find a successor. He says: "My successor could either be an internal promotion or an external candidate."

Duroux joined CLT in 1994 as general manager of the struggling CHR M40, and transformed it into successful AC station RTL2. He then became president of Fun Radio in 1997 when the station's president Benoit Sillard left the group.

Remy also reports good listener response for *Adelante*, which is currently getting 20 plays a week at the station. Voltage FM was the first French broadcaster to play his breakthrough record, *Encore Une Fois*, and has traditionally been a big supporter.

Sash! has completed the new album in between fulfilling his DJ-ing responsibilities all over the world, and edel's international VP, A&R Michel Petre, tells M&M that the tracks he has heard from *Trilenium* lean even more towards the clubs, describing them as "more clubby than previous material."

Meanwhile, Jurgen Schuback of edel's radio promotion department in Germany says *Adelante* has been well received at radio ahead of its commercial release. "Considering how R&B has replaced dance music on many German playlists, reaction from programmers has been good," he says. "The number of plays is continuing to build."

Sash! has placed singles on M&M's year-end European Top 100 Singles charts for the past two

years, with *Stay*, featuring La Trec, at number 39 for 1997 and *Mysterious Times*, with Tina Cousins, at 54 for 1998. The DJ left a particularly deep imprint on the pop and club scenes in the UK, where he registered five straight top three hits, with *Encore Une Fois* selling over half a million copies as his three 1997 singles reached combined sales of 1.5 million units.

Multiply also reports UK sales of 500,000 for the *It's My Life* album, after which Sash! received a nomination at the 1998 Brit Awards in the Best International Artist category, and a further 300,000 for the *Life Goes On* set. His three 1998 singles achieved British sales of 900,000.

Mixes of *Adelante* include versions by the UK production outfit Ruff Driverz, 2 Funky People, Dumonde, Avancada and Cosmic Gate, and a 59-13 climb on Germany's DMC club chart is another early indication that Sash!'s achievements will continue to demand that exclamation mark after his name.

that the new system is any sort of attempt to "punish" radio stations. "The fact that many commercial stations play well-known hits is to meet demand. If the record industry substantially limits joint activities with such broadcasters, this should not be misconstrued as an attempt to punish or convert them. But the industry's aim must be to support quality airplay."

More worryingly for the radio industry, the chairman of the BPW's marketing committee and WEA Germany managing director Bernd Dopp hints that those "joint activities" could also include new-release information and opportunities for artist interviews and concert sponsorship.

The BPW statement has been met with an angry response from Thorsten Grothe, head of European affairs at VPRT, who says: "This is an autocratic decision by the BPW." He has announced that the VPRT will hold a joint press conference in two weeks' time to announce its own plans to increase the exposure of new artists.

Matthias Holtmann, head of music at public Hot AC SWR 3 says "this is the wrong way to improve the quota of new releases [being played]. It doesn't make sense to punish stations with a big [audience] reach for the lack of new artists."

Explaining the BPW's case, Dopp says: "In the interests of our artists, we can no longer tolerate a situation in which millions of radio listeners are caught in a musical ghetto. After all, the German record companies invest millions in new releases, guaranteeing a wide variety of music on the market". He says stations playing

"Hits from the '70s and '80s" and other such formats do not accurately reflect the music scene. "After all, the German car market does not only comprise 15-year-old used cars, but constantly captures consumers' imagination with new models."

Public broadcasters, which Renner says "are not performing their cultural duties," have come in for particularly harsh criticism from BPW members. "Many of them are slavishly copying the monoculture of commercial radio," says Dopp.

BPW managing director Peter Zombik warns the radio industry that listeners are becoming frustrated with unimaginative programmes, and are defecting to the Internet. "Mainstream has become boring," he says. "Trend-oriented target groups are losing interest in what radio currently has to offer."

Intense speculation surrounds the question of who will replace **Axel Duroux** as president of **Fun Radio** and **RTL2** in Paris following his resignation (see story, front page). Some sources say that parent company **CLT-UFA** might take this opportunity to realign all their radio businesses in France under a single leadership. Duroux had been reporting to Luxembourg-based **CLT-UFA** executive VP for radio **Jean-Michel Kerdraon**, and not to **Jacques Rigaud**, president/CEO of the company's French flagship station, full-service **RTL**. As Rigaud is due to retire next year and be replaced by current VP and general manager for programmes **Philippe Labro**, it is anticipated that Labro could also add Fun and RTL2 to his portfolio.

It's business as usual for **Oasis** following last week's news of **Creation** founder **Alan McGee's** departure from the label (M&M, December 4). According to head of press **Johnny Hopkins**, the February 28 release of the band's fourth album, *Standing On The Shoulders Of Giants*, will go ahead on Creation in the UK and via Sony's **SINE** division internationally. "The record's coming out as planned, and the gigs next year will be as planned, with the same [promotions] team that's worked on all the Oasis records," he tells Hotline.

The third biggest German online provider, **germany.net**, is starting a new music channel featuring fully legal downloadable MP3 music files. The company is cooperating with **mp3-onlineshop.com** and the Munich-based **ArtVoice** group for licensing.

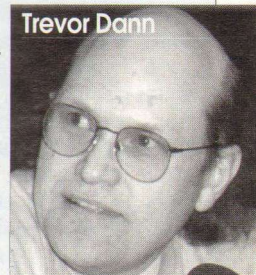
Remotemusic.com, described by director of A&R **Clive Black** as "the first record company on the Internet actively signing acts," went live on December 1. Based in London, the label is headed by managing director and rock photographer **Denis O'Regan**. Remotemusic has the digital rights to **Cliff Richard's** *The Millennium Prayer*, on the **Chrysalis Group's** **Papillon** label, and is offering the regular version or two other mixes as one-track downloads for £1 (euro 1.56) or equivalent via **Microsoft Windows Media**. Profits will be channelled by the artist's **Cliff Richard Organisation** to children's charities.

David Bowie has been invited to be the keynote speaker at new media conference **Midemnet**, to be held for the first time next year in Cannes on January 22. Although Bowie has always been reluctant to attend these types of gathering, the organisers of the show still hope that the artist, whose latest album *Hours...* was available for downloads in the US a week prior to its retail release, will grace them with his presence.

British radio group **UKRD** is adding to its collection of stations following its acquisition of **Dawe Media** for an undisclosed fee. Dawe's stations comprise **KLFM/King's Lynn**, **Cambridge Red Radio** and **Oxygen 107.9/Oxford**. Dawe Media founder **Peter Dawe** will retain a shareholding in UKRD.

Finally, the **Country Music Association** has honoured **Trevor Dann**, head of music entertainment at UK public broadcaster the BBC, presenting him with its annual **Wesley Rose** international media achievement award. CMA executive director **Ed Benson** praised Dann for continuing advocacy of country music programming on the corporation's TV and radio outlets.
