Ward 1 Clackmannanshire West

I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 1 Clackmannanshire West. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 8,936 and the number of ballot papers received was 3,754 giving a percentage turnout of $42.0 \%$. There were 111 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 729 .
