Description

Regional Significance Statement

Significant in size, with access to Big Elk Lake's undeveloped shoreline, the Elk River and Lily Creek the property is a high priority for protection to create quality opportunities for nature based outdoor recreation on a diverse landscape. Potential eligibility for the National Register of Historic Places for cultural resources elevates it even further. Sherburne County has yet to invest in regional parks and would like to ensure this land is preserved for that purpose.

Natural Resource Based Regional Park

Overview/Description of Park or Trail

The late property owner envisioned his beloved acreage as a regional park for people to enjoy nature and gain an appreciation for cultural history. Soon after his passing the family contacted Sherburne County Parks & Recreation to pursue their late fathers goal. The County does not yet own the property. After completing an appraisal, an environmental site assessment, a phase one archaeological survey and a phase one historic architectural survey the County is prepared to move into the acquisition process and has partnered with Trust for Public Land to protect this parcel, which provides 1 mile of natural undeveloped shoreline on Big Elk Lake, 4,800 feet of Elk River and 2,400 feet of Lily Creek. Approximately 115 acres are a mixture of wetland and floodplain. Large, open grown bur oaks provide the framework for oak savanna restoration on 25 acres. Over 200 acres is currently leased for agricultural production and is space for a variety of options that include prairie restoration, camping and nature playscapes. An Indian burial mound group was identified on this property in 1886 and later reported on in 1911. In 1957 two of the mounds were excavated by the University of Minnesota (a practice which would not occur in a typical archaeological setting today). We conducted a phase 1 archaeological survey in 2020, which documented nine find sites and significant evidence of living

and trading by indigenous peoples. Over 800 prehistoric artifacts were collected and analyzed including pottery sherds, a copper awl, bifaces, fire cracked rock, cores and lithic flakes. The mineral materials used originated from immediate locality, but also Iowa, Missouri, North Dakota and Wisconsin. Ultimately the archaeological survey recommends that six of the nine find sites should have a phase two archaeological survey because they are potentially eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is home to many structures that were recently included in a phase 1 historic architectural survey. Six of the buildings are potentially eligible for the National Register of Historic Places and include two 1910 vacation cottages (linked to the Author Sinclair Lewis), a stone fireplace, a 1916 dairy barn, storage house and a home. Further analysis would be required to determine eligibility. Ability to retain buildings is uncertain at this time. Costs and feasibility need to be explored further before determining their fate. The entire property holds incredible opportunities for outdoor recreation in a wide variety of land cover types, as well as environmental and cultural education.

General Site Characteristics

The site includes wide-open rolling hills and meadows, intimate wooded river corridors, a sheltered lake shoreline and oak grove, and long vistas to the east; all of which provide a glimpse into central Minnesota's historic natural landscape that today exists in few places. There is a small inholding on the lake shoreline, it is the goal of Sherburne County to obtain the one inholding property by securing "right of first refusal" from the homeowners. The homeowners maintain correspondence with the County about the timeline for the sale of their property - based on their ability to live independently in their home because of their age. Big Elk Lake currently has a public water access on the south end of the lake. This park would offer carry in for non-motorized water craft. Through restoration efforts the site will offer variety of landcover types including

wetland, floodplain, oak savanna, restored prairie and upland forest.

Sherburne County Parks & Recreation has contracted with a consulting firm to facilitate the master planning process. Our project advisory committee includes critical stakeholders to ensure thoughtful development, including the Minnesota Indian Affairs Council and Tribal Historic Preservation Officers from all interested tribal communities in MN (both the Upper and Lower Sioux Communities, Shakopee Mdewakanton Sioux Community, Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe and Prairie Island Indian Community). The MN Indian Affairs Council is drafting a Mound Management Plan to guide design of park development. We are looking forward to our first public engagement event on January 30th, which is complimented by an online engagement platform. We will host a second round of public engagement in the spring of 2021 and are on schedule to have a master plan complete in June of 2021.

The subject property is nestled in the middle of a chain for four lakes and occupies one mile of natural, undeveloped shoreline, providing panoramic views of Big Elk Lake. The anticipated trail system will offer nature experiences through not only native prairie, oak savanna and forest, but also over wetlands, Lily Creek and the Elk River. Park visitors will enjoy vistas of scenic country side uninterrupted by noise pollution from major thoroughfares or large urban centers, as its location is miles from state highways or federal interstates. Outreach to local schools, home school coops, and events for families will provide for more interactive learning opportunities.

Preserves a Regionally-Significant and Diverse Natural or Historic Landscape

In 2020, Sherburne County conducted a Phase 1 Archaeological Survey on the site with the knowledge that Indian Burial Mounds were present. This group of 26 mounds, known as the Moorhouse Mounds (named after a historic property owners), is located along the northern shore of Big Elk Lake and was first identified by Theodore H. Lewis in 1886 and later reported by Winchell in 1911. In 1957, two mounds in the group were excavated by a University of Minnesota team that was led by Lloyd Wilford. The 2020 survey work yielded an artifact collection that includes 846 prehistoric artifacts that were collected from nine different sites. These artifacts included 18 bifaces/biface fragments (arrowheads), 1 copper awl, hundreds of flakes and fragments, 27 pieces of fire-cracked rock and 43 pieces of potsherds from pottery vessels. The collection suggests a long prehistoric presence in the area spanning hundreds of years before, during and after the mound group was constructed. The diagnostic artifacts show occupation began during the Archaic Period as short-term habitation camps used during seasonal migration. Over time, larger, longer habitation was practiced during the Woodland Period; which includes when the Moorhouse Mounds were constructed. Additional Mound groups within two miles of this property provide evidence that this portion of the County held special significance to Native Americans. The Archaeology Survey Report recommends that six of the nine artifact finds sites are potentially eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

The diverse range of natural cover types that characterize these 430 acres holds great potential for restoration on habitats that include forested river floodplain, oak savanna, wetlands, upland prairie and dry oak forest. The MN Biological Survey has mapped a portion of the property as having moderate biodiversity.

Well-located and Connected to Serve a Regional Population and/or Tourist Destination

The location of this property will provide for both local use and draw from the great region. Less than 5 miles north of State Highway 10 between St. Cloud and the Twin Cities, the locality is easily accessible for day trips or weekend camping excursions. Hundreds of lakeshore owners enjoy their own shoreline within just a few miles of this park land, but lack open space and trails that contribute to healthy, active lifestyles. Additionally rural residential developments are continuing to sprawl into this region adding thousands more individuals seeking solace in high quality natural recreation spaces.

Fills a Gap in Recreational Opportunity within the Region

Public lakeshore that can be used for fishing, swimming or carry in water craft is limited to a small number in Sherburne County, with the closest fishing pier in the City of Big Lake, the second public fishing pier in the County is found in Elk River on Lake Orono. The additional open space, preserved natural features, and potential habitat restoration areas of this property will fill a gap in regional parks in the County.
