## ONE WIN AWAY

The Nuggets are officially on the doorstep of history. The series is far from over, however their game four win over Miami 108-95 has put Denver in the driver's seat up 3-1. **The Nuggets used an all-around team performance as three players scored 20+ points, led by Aaron Gordon who posted a playoff career-high 27 points, seven rebounds and six assists in 42 minutes to help lead Denver to the victory. Here are a few other key notes from the big win:**

- Jamal Murray finished with 12 assists after having 10 assists in each of the first three games of the series. He joins Magic Johnson as the only players to have 10 or more assists in four consecutive games in a single NBA Finals series. Johnson did it four times (1983, 1984, 1985 and 1991).
- Murray is the first player to have at least 10 assists in each of his first four career NBA Finals games. (He was already the first to do it in his first three.)
- Nikola Jokić has become the first player to have at least 500 points, 250 rebounds and 150 assists in a single postseason.'
- Nuggets forward Aaron Gordon set a playoff career high with 27 points. His previous playoff high was 25 points for the Magic against the Raptors on April 21, 2019.

## A DUO SWEETER THAN PB&J

After dropping game two at home, the Nuggets entered Miami-Dade County looking to gain back home court advantage and were able to earn a pivotal 109-94 victory. When they needed their stars the most, they both showed up as Jamal Murray and Nikola Jokić put together an all-time Finals performance. **Jokić finished with 32 points (12-21 FG's), 21 rebounds and 10 assists while Murray added 34 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists to become the first two teammates in NBA history (regular season & postseason) to record 30+ point triple-doubles in a game.** A few more notes from the duo's big night:

- It was also the second time that teammates have had any kind of triple-double in a playoff game (Stephen Curry and Draymond Green 2019).
- Joker notched his third career playoff game with at least 30 points, 20 rebounds and 10 assists (including his second of the 2023 postseason). He has three of the five 30/20/10 games in playoff history, with Wilt Chamberlain (1967) and Kareem Abdul-Jabbar (1970) having one each.
- Murray has had 10 assists in each of the three games in this series. He is the first player to record at least 10 assists in each of his first three career NBA Finals games.
- Jokić is the first player to have at least 30 points, 20 rebounds and 10 assists in an NBA Finals game.
- Jokić has scored 100 points in his first three career NBA Finals games. Only four players have scored more points through three career NBA Finals games: Rick Barry (122 in 1967), Allen Iverson (106 in 2001), Willis Reed (104 in 1970) and Giannis Antetokounmpo (103 in 2021).

## 500/200/150

Nikola Jokić is truly on one of the most historical playoff runs in NBA history and he continues to add to his stretch. Despite the 111-108 game two loss to the Heat, Jokić finished with a series-high 41 points (16-28 FG, 2-5 3FG, 7-8 FT), a series-high 11 rebounds and four assists in a series-high 42 minutes for his 47th career playoff double-double and 14th of this postseason. The big man now has four career playoff games with 40+ points, tying Alex English for second all-time in Nuggets history, only trailing Jamal Murray with five.

**As well, Jokić becomes the third player in NBA postseason history to record 500 points, 200 rebounds and 150 assists in a single playoff run joining LeBron James (2015-18, & 2020) and Larry Bird (1987).**

## JOKER AND JAMAL LEAD THE WAY

The Nuggets won their first ever Finals game in front of a crowd that has been waiting a lifetime to see it. Nikola Jokić and Jamal Murray put on a show at Ball Arena as Denver took a 1-0 series lead, defeating the Heat 104-93. The win marked the Nuggets ninth straight win at home this postseason, the longest playoff home winning streak in franchise history. Jokić recorded 27 points (8-12 FG, 1-2 3FG, 10-12 FT), 10 rebounds and 14 assists in 40 minutes for his 15th career playoff triple-double and ninth of this postseason while Murray added 26 points (11-22 FG, 2-2 FT), six rebounds and a playoff season-high 10 assists in a playoff season-high 44 minutes for his fifth career playoff double-double and second of this postseason. A few other notes:

- Jokić and Murray join Magic Johnson and James Worthy as the only pair of teammates to have 25+ points and 10+ assists in an NBA Finals game.
- Jokić is just the second player (Jason Kidd) in NBA playoff history to post a triple-double in his NBA Finals debut.
- The Nuggets are 6-1 all-time when Murray has 9+ assists in the playoffs.
- Aaron Gordon posted 16 points (7-10 FG, 2-2 FT) and six rebounds in 36 minutes ... It was Gordon's seventh career playoff game with 16+ points and 6+ rebounds, with the Nuggets going 3-0 so far this postseason when he does so.
- Michael Porter Jr. registered 14 points, a playoff career-high 13 rebounds and a playoff career-high tying two blocks in a playoff season-high 43 minutes for his 10th career playoff double-double and seventh of this postseason

## FINALS FOR THE FIRST TIME EVER

Denver entered the NBA in 1976 and played their first ever game on 10/22/76. Since then, the Nuggets have played 4,012 games (3,787 regular season and 225 playoffs) and finally after all those years, the Nuggets will host the Miami Heat in their first ever Finals game.

**The Nuggets swept their way through the Western Conference Finals against the Los Angeles Lakers, winning game four 113-111, sweeping their first ever series and advancing to their first ever NBA finals. The Lakers led by 15 in the game, yet Denver came back to win, it was their biggest deficit overcome in the NBA playoffs in a road game since 1997 (excluding the 2020 bubble games). The Joker would cap his amazing series by averaging a triple double (27.8 PTS, 14.5 REB, 11.8 AST) becoming just the fourth player to average a triple-double in a Conference Finals. He would go on to win the Western Conference Finals MVP trophy. So far in his 15 games of the 2023 playoffs, Jokić has 449 points, 199 rebounds and 154 assists. In the history of the NBA, it's just the sixth time any player has had those numbers in an entire playoff season.**





## ON THE VERGE OF HISTORY...

The Nuggets are on the verge of doing something no other team in franchise history has done before, make the NBA finals. Denver controlled game three from the tip and used a late 13-0 run in the fourth quarter to put the Lakers away, winning 119-108. The victory gives the Nuggets a 3-0 series lead where in game four they can accomplish another thing they have never done before, sweep a team in the playoffs. **Jamal Murray was red hot, scoring 30 points in the first half, becoming the eighth player since 1997 to have 30+ points in the first half on the road of a playoff game. The two-man game of Murray and Jokić brought the Nuggets home late as Jokić scored 15 points in the final quarter. A few more notes:**

- Bruce Brown finished with 15 points, five rebounds and five assists in 29 minutes, becoming the first bench player with those numbers and zero turnovers in the playoffs since Andre Iguodala in 2015.
- Murray's 30-points first half was his third career 30+ point half in the playoffs, tied for the second most since 1997. Dating back to the fourth quarter of game two through halftime of game three, Jamal Murray scored 53 points over a three-quarter span, the most in a three-quarter stretch since the 1998 playoffs.

## MURRAY TIME IN THE FOURTH

In a pivotal game two that saw the Nuggets down for most of the game, Jamal Murray put on a show in the fourth quarter propelling his team to a 108-103 victory. It was their fourth straight win and ninth straight at home (dating back to last season) in the playoffs, the longest playoff home winning streak in franchise history.

**The Blue Arrow finished with a series-high 37 points (11-24 FG, 6-14 3FG, 9-10 FT), a playoff season-high 10 rebounds, five assists and a playoff season-high four steals in a playoff season-high 43 minutes for his fourth career playoff double-double.**

**He becomes the first player this postseason with 37/10/5/4 and the eighth player in the NBA since 1982-83 with that line in the playoffs, the Nuggets also moved to 10-4 all-time in the postseason when Murray scores 30+ points.**

## IN MALONE WE TRUST

There has been consistency within the Nuggets organization over the last several years and it starts at the top with Head Coach Michael Malone. Coach Malone has done a lot of winning with the Nuggets in his tenure and now holds the most victories in the postseason in franchise history. Under Malone, the Nuggets have now advanced to the Western Conference semi-finals for the fourth time in the last five season.

## JOKIĆ SHOWS OUT IN GAME ONE

Nikola Jokić once again is doing things few before him have done in NBA history. The big man had an all-time game one of the Western Conference Finals, finishing with 34 points (12-17 FG, 3-3 3FG, 7-8 FT), a playoff season-high 21 rebounds, 14 assists and a playoff season-high tying two blocks in a playoff season-high tying 42 minutes for his 12th career playoff triple-double and sixth of this postseason. **He is the first player in NBA playoff history with 34+ points, 21+ rebounds and 14+ assists and his 12-career playoff triple-double is tied for the third all-time, joining Magic Johnson (30), LeBron James (28) and Russell Westbrook (12) as the only four with 12+.** Some other notes:

- Only player in NBA history with multiple playoff games of 30+ points, 20+ rebounds and 10+ assists (Chamberlain and Abdul-Jabbar each have one).
- First player in the shot clock era to record 30+ points, 20+ rebounds and 10+ assists while shooting 70% from the field in a playoff game.
- Moved into third place all-time for playoff triple-doubles.
- His 16 first half rebounds were tied for the second most all-time in a half in a playoff game.

## NUGGETS TAKE THE FIRST

The sold-out crowd at Ball Arena for game one of the Western Conference Finals was electric. The Nuggets fed off their energy, taking down the Lakers 132-126 on 5/16 to take a 1-0 series lead. **Five Nuggets scored 15+ points, just the third time that has happened in the playoffs in franchise history and the first time since 5/13/09 vs. DAL. As well, Denver scored a playoff season-high 132 points, their most in a regulation playoff game since 1986 and are now 24-5 all-time at home in the playoffs when scoring 120+ points.** A few other highlights from the victory:

- Denver improved to 9-3 overall and 7-0 at Ball Arena in the 2023 postseason, this is the longest playoff home winning streak in franchise history.
- The Nuggets outrebounded the Lakers 47-30, moving to 9-1 overall and 7-0 at home this postseason when outrebounding their opponents.
- Jamal Murray finished with 31 points (12-20 FG, 4-8 3FG, 3-3 FT), five rebounds, five assists and three steals in 37 minutes. The Nuggets are 9-4 all-time in the postseason when Murray scores 30+ points. Murray also passed Carmelo Anthony in third place for most playoff points in franchise history.
- Kentavious Caldwell-Pope posted a playoff career-high tying 21 points (9-17 FG, 3-8 3FG), two rebounds, a playoff season-high tying three assists and a playoff season-high two steals in 36 minutes.

## WESTERN CONFERENCE FINALS BOUND

This Nuggets team continues to be something special this season as their playoff run continues, now in the Western Conference Finals. Denver took down the Phoenix Suns in blowout fashion 125-100 in game six to win the series 4-2. **The Nuggets have now won six playoff series in the last five years after previously winning five total from 1985 to 2018. It also marks Denver's fifth WCF appearance in franchise history and the second appearance in the last four seasons (2020). A few other notes include:**

- Nikola Jokić become the third player in NBA history to average a 30-point triple-double in a playoff series.
- Jokić joins Steve Nash as the only two players in NBA history to have four straight playoff games with 11+FGM and 11+ assists.
- The Joker had 207 points, 79 rebounds, and 62 assists, all Nuggets records for a 6-game series.





- **The Nuggets** defeated the Miami Heat on the road in game four on **6/9**, moving the series to 3-1 ... Denver extended its road winning streak to five games, the longest streak in franchise history.
- **The Nuggets** shot 50.0% from three-point range (14-of-28) in game four **at MIA on 6/9** ... It was their highest mark of the 2023 postseason.
- **Bruce Brown** finished with 21 points on 8-11 shooting along with scoring 11 in the final quarter, four rebounds and two assists in 30 **minutes vs. MIA on 6/9** ... It marks the first time since 6/2/22 that a player scored 20+ points off the bench in a finals game.
- **Denver** took down the Miami Heat in a pivotal game three on the road on **6/7**, moving the series to 2-1 in their favor ... The Nuggets outrebounded the Heat 58-33 – a difference of 25 rebounds ... It was the first time that a team was at least plus-25 in rebounding in an NBA Finals game since 1972, when the Lakers outrebounded the Knicks by 28 (67-39) in game five.
- **Nikola Jokic** posted 32 points (12-21 FG's), 21 rebounds and 10 assists in 44 minutes **at MIA on 6/7** ... He is the first player to have at least 30 points, 20 rebounds and 10 assists in an NBA Finals game.
- **Christian Braun** scored 15 points and made 7-of-8 shots from the field **at MIA on 6/7** ... It was his first double-digit scoring performance in 17 career playoff games ... He had two regular-season games of 15 or more points in 2022-23, including a career-high 19 points against the Timberwolves on Feb. 5.
- **The Nuggets** fell 111-108 at home in game two of the Finals on **6/4** ... Denver outrebounded Miami 38-31, moving to 12-2 overall and 8-1 at home this postseason when outrebounding their opponents ... Miami's 31 rebounds were the third fewest Denver has allowed in these playoffs.
- **Miami** scored 36 points in the fourth quarter in **game two on 6/4** ... They also shot 69% from the field and 56% from deep ... This is just the sixth time that Denver has allowed that many fourth quarter points in a home playoff game in team history.
- **Bruce Brown** registered a series-high 11 points (4-9 FG, 1-3 3FG, 2-2 FT), a series-high tying five rebounds and a series-high two steals in a series-high 27 minutes off the bench in game two on 6/4 ... It was Brown's fourth career playoff game with 11+ points, 5+ rebounds and 2+ steals ... Brown now has 2+ steals in five games this postseason, tied for the third most among the Nuggets in these playoffs.
- **Nikola Jokic** recorded a series-high 41 points (16-28 FG, 2-5 3FG, 7-8 FT), a series-high 11 rebounds and four assists in a series-high 42 minutes for his 47th career playoff double-double and 14th of this postseason ... Jokic now has four career playoff games with 40+ points, tying Alex English for second all-time in Nuggets history, only trailing Jamal Murray with five.
- **Denver** beat the Heat in Game one of the Finals 104-93 on **6/1** to take a 1-0 lead ... The Nuggets held the Heat to just 93 points, the third time this postseason the Nuggets have held their opponent to under 100 points (3-0).
- **Nikola Jokic** recorded 27 points (8-12 FG, 1-2 3FG, 10-12 FT), 10 rebounds and 14 assists in 40 minutes for his 15th career playoff triple-double and ninth of this postseason **vs. MIA on 6/1** ... Jokic is just the second player (Jason Kidd) in NBA playoff history to post a triple-double in his NBA Finals debut.
- **Jamal Murray** finished with 26 points (11-22 FG, 2-2 FT), six rebounds and a playoff season-high 10 assists in a playoff season-high 44 minutes for his fifth career playoff double-double and second of this postseason **vs. MIA on 6/1** ... It was Murray's second career playoff game with 26+ points, 6+ rebounds and 10+ assists ... The Nuggets are 6-1 all-time when Murray has 9+ assists in the playoffs.
- **The Nuggets** took down the Los Angeles Lakers on the road in game four 113-111 on 5/22, sweeping the Lakers 4-0 ... The Lakers led by 15 yet Denver came back to win. That is the biggest deficit the Nuggets have overcome in NBA playoffs in a road game since 1997 to win (excluding the 2020 bubble games).
- **In his 15 games** of the 2023 playoffs so far, Nikola Jokić has 449 points, 199 rebounds and 154 assists. In the history of the NBA, it's just the 6th time any player has had those numbers in an entire playoff season.
- **Denver** beat the Los Angeles Lakers 119-108 on the road in game three to gain a 3-0 series lead ... It is the second time these playoffs the Nuggets have held a 3-0 series lead over an opponent (first round vs. MIN) ... They have never swept a team in the playoffs in franchise history.
- **Bruce Brown** finished with 15 points, five rebounds and five assists in 29 minutes off the bench **at LAL on 5/20** ... He becomes the first bench player since Andre Iguodala in 2015 to post those numbers with zero turnovers in a playoff game.





- **Jamal Murray** posted 37 points (15-29 FG's), seven rebounds and six assists in 42 minutes in game three **at LAL on 5/20** ... Murray scored 30 points in the first half, his third career 30-point half in the playoffs, tied for the second most since 1997 ... Murray scored 53 points in a three-quarter stretch, the most points over three quarters in the playoffs since 1998.
- **The Nuggets** took down the Los Angeles Lakers 108-103 at home in game two **on 5/18** ... This is the seventh time in franchise history (third time this postseason) the Nuggets have started a playoff series with a 2-0 lead, they won each of the previous six.
- **Denver** has now won 42 combined home games this season regular and postseason, the most in franchise history.
- **Nikola Jokic** recorded 23 points (9-21 FG, 5-6 FT), 17 rebounds, 12 assists and a playoff season-high tying three steals in a playoff season-high tying 42 minutes for his 13th career playoff triple-double and seventh of this postseason **vs. LAL on 5/18** ... He now has 13 career postseason triple doubles, the third most all-time ... It was Jokic's first career playoff game with 23+ points, 17+ rebounds, 12+ assists and 3+ steals. He is just the second player in NBA playoff history (LeBron James) since 1982-83 with 23/17/12/3.
- **Michael Porter Jr.** posted a playoff series-high 16 points (5-10 FG, 4-7 3FG, 2-2 FT), seven rebounds and a series-high three assists in 31 minutes **vs. LAL on 5/18** ... It was Porter Jr.'s second career playoff game 16+ points, 7+ rebounds and 3+ assists ... The Nuggets are 6-2 this postseason when Porter Jr. has 7+ rebounds.
- **Denver** beat the Los Angeles Lakers 132-126 in game one of the Western Conference Finals **on 5/16** ... The Nuggets scored a playoff season-high 132 points tonight, their most in a regulation playoff game since 1986 ... Denver is now 24-5 all-time at home in the playoffs when scoring 120+ points ... It was the second most points the Lakers ever allowed in regulation during the playoffs.
- **Five Nuggets** scored 15+ points in **game one vs. LAL on 5/16** ... It was just the third time this has happened in the playoffs in franchise history and first time since 5/13/09 vs. DAL ... It was the 12th time in Nuggets playoff history that two players scored 30+ points.
- **Jamal Murray** finished with 31 points (12-20 FG, 4-8 3FG, 3-3 FT), five rebounds, five assists and three steals in 37 minutes in **game one vs. LAL on 5/16** ... The Nuggets are 9-4 all-time in the postseason when Murray scores 30+ points ... Murray now has back-to-back games with 3+ steals, having only done it once prior to these playoffs.
- **Kentavious Caldwell-Pope** posted a playoff career-high tying 21 points (9-17 FG, 3-8 3FG), two rebounds, a playoff season-high tying three assists and a playoff season-high two steals in 36 minutes **game one vs. LAL on 5/16** ... Caldwell-Pope has 3+ assists in three straight games (3-0) and has eight career 3+ assist games in the playoffs (6-2) ... The nine field goals and 17 attempts were both playoff career-highs.
- **The Nuggets** defeated the Phoenix Suns at Footprint center in game six, winning their second round series 4-2 ... It was their second biggest win (25 points) on the road in the playoffs in team history ... The Nuggets won by 58 at the Hornets in 2009.
- **Denver** scored 44 points in the first quarter **at PHX on 5/11** ... The 44 points is tied for the second most points Denver has ever scored in any quarter in the playoffs in team history.
- **Kentavious Caldwell-Pope** posted 21 points (7-11 FG's, 2-5 3FG's), five rebounds and three assists in 36 minutes **at PHX in game six on 5/11** ... He scored 17 in the first quarter, tying for the third most he has scored in any quarter in his career (regular season or postseason) ... It was the he has scored in a quarter since he had 21 in the 2nd quarter at the Bucks on 3/19/19.
- **Denver** beat the Phoenix Suns 118-102 at home in **game five on 5/9** moving the series to 3-2 in their favor ... The Nuggets scored 31 fast break points, the most ever in playoff franchise history since 1997, when the stat first was tracked ... The 31 points are the most in any playoff game since the Warriors had 32 vs. TOR on 6/7/19.
- **The Nuggets** handed out a playoff season-high tying 32 assists in **game five vs. PHX on 5/9** ... It was the sixth time since 2009 (second this year) that Denver has had 30+ assists in a playoff game
- **Bruce Brown** registered a playoff season-high 25 points (7-11 FG, 2-4 3FG, 9-10 FT) and a series-high five rebounds in a series-high 27 minutes off the bench in game **five vs. PHX on 5/9** ... It was Brown's second career playoff game (first off the bench) with 25+ points and 5+ rebounds ... Brown is only the third player (Hachimura and Monk) in the 2023 postseason with 25+ points and 5+ rebounds off the bench ... It was the 12th time in franchise history and just second since 2013 that a Nugget reserve had 25+ points in the playoffs.
- **Michael Porter Jr.** posted 19 points (7-11 FG, 5-8 3FG), eight rebounds and two assists in 28 minutes in **game five vs. PHX on 5/9** ... This is Porter Jr.'s third career playoff game with 19+ points, 8+ rebounds and 2+ assists (3-0) ... This was the fourth game this postseason that Porter Jr. made 4+ three-pointers (3-1), tied with Jamal Murray for the most games in these playoffs so far.





## WEST COMES THROUGH DENVER

The Nuggets have accomplished something that no other team had previously done in their NBA franchise history. With the Grizzlies loss on 4/5, **Denver clinched the #1 seed in the Western Conference playoffs which gives them a big advantage as they have gone 33-7 at home this season. They also became the sixth different team in the past six seasons to have the most wins in the Western Conference.**

## MPJ CLIMBING THE RANKS

Michael Porter Jr. is having one of the best seasons from long range in Nuggets history and his name is getting close to being cemented in the record books forever. MPJ has connected on 185 three-point field goals this season, only seven off the all-time mark of 192 set by Dale Ellis in 1996-97.

## SQUAD STEPPING UP

The Nuggets were without Nikola Jokic for the third straight game due to injury and needed a win to snap their two-game losing streak. Michael Porter Jr, Jamal Murray and the rest of the squad played team basketball on both ends of the floor and took down the Warriors 112-110 on 4/2. The Nuggets held Golden State to just 9-42 (.214) from deep, the sixth lowest 3FG% allowed by the Nuggets this season and the lowest 3FG% by the Warriors this year and Denver registered 10 steals for the 19th time this season and are now 16-3 overall and 10-0 at home when getting 10+ steals. A few other highlights from the game

- The Nuggets came back after being down 15 at one point, which ties for the third largest deficit overcome in a win this season.
- Michael Porter Jr. finished with 29 points (10-17 FG, 4-8 3FG, 5-6 FT) and 11 rebounds in 34 minutes for his third double-double ... The Nuggets improve to 23-5 when Porter Jr. puts up a double-double.
- Denver grabbed 17 offensive rebounds, tied for the second most this season and are 4-1 when getting 17+ offensive boards.

## FIFTY WINS

It was a big game at Ball Arena on 3/25 as the Nuggets returned home and faced off in a battle of #1 seeds. The Nuggets had a huge second half, holding the Bucks to just 40 points on 31% shooting and forced eight turnovers to win 129-106. The 40 points was tied for a season low in a half by the Bucks this season. Jamal Murray finished with 26 points (9-19 FG, 5-10 3FG), six rebounds and nine assists in 33 minutes, **it marked his first career game with 26+ points, 6+ rebounds and 9+ assists and the Nuggets are 14-4 this season when Murray has 8+ assists.**

**The victory also marked the 50<sup>th</sup> win on the season, it makes it the 10th time in their NBA franchise history and the first time since 2017-18 (54) they have won 50+ games in a season.**

## BIG 3 IN BROOKLYN

The Nuggets continued their longest road trip of the season on the second night of a back-to-back against Brooklyn on Sunday, March 19<sup>th</sup>. After a loss the day before, Denver used a balanced attack from their big three to get out to a fast start and never looked back. Jokic, Porter Jr, and Murray combined for 75 points, 27 rebounds and 21 assists as Denver won 108-102.

**Murray scored 20 points in the first quarter, tied for the second most in a single quarter in his career. It marked only the third time that MPJ and Jamal have scored 25+ points each in a game, moving to 3-0 in such games. It also marked the 37<sup>th</sup> time this season (most in the NBA) that the Nuggets had 30+ assists, the third most games in a season in franchise history (83-84 - 46 games, 82-83 - 38 games).**

## BACK ON TRACK

Like all teams do, the Nuggets faced some of adversity over the past two weeks and they continued their five-game road trip in Detroit looking to snap their four game losing streak. Denver stepped up big, as their starting unit dominated the game and outscored the Pistons 33-14 in the fourth quarter to earn a 119-100 win. All five starters had 15 points, led by Nikola Jokic with 30, Kentavious Caldwell-Pope with 20 and Jamal Murray added 19 points and 10 assists. **It was only the 21<sup>st</sup> time in franchise history that all five starters recorded 15+ points.**

**As well, the win stopped their losing streak at four games, since the 2016-17 season, in games in which Nikola Jokic played, the Nuggets have not recorded a losing streak longer than five games.**

## THE KID FROM KITCHENER AT THE TOP

Jamal Murray continues to climb multiple Nuggets franchise all-time leaderboards, but for three-point field goals, he now sits alone for the most franchise history. Murray hit his 805th career three pointer in the first quarter at San Antonio on 3/10.

## 45 WINS AND COUNTING

The Nuggets had a big game against the Memphis Grizzlies at home on 3/3 and they delivered with a 113-97 victory, advancing their lead for the #1 seed to six games. The 97 points allowed moved Denver to 7-0 this season when holding opponents under 100 points and it was the second time this season they held the Grizzlies under 100 points. The Grizzlies shot 31-84 (.369) from the field, a season-low by a Nugget opponent, the Nuggets (.460) outshot the Grizzlies, moving to 41-3 overall and 28-1 at home when outshooting their opponent this season.

**With the win, the Nuggets become the only NBA team to have 45+ wins in each of the last six seasons (from 2017-18 through 2022-23) and no other team can equal that this year.**







## MURRAY AND MIKE - ALWAYS DELIVER

After a two-game road trip the Nuggets returned home to a sold-out crowd at Ball Arena on 2/26 and rewarded the playoff atmosphere with a 134-124 overtime win. Denver had a great game from their starting five, but Michael Porter Jr. and Jamal Murray vaulted them to victory.

**Porter Jr. finished with 29 points (12-18 FG, 4-8 3FG) and 11 rebounds in a season-high 39 minutes for his second double-double of the year. It was his third career game with 29+ points and 11+ rebounds (3-0) and the Nuggets moved to 23-5 all-time when he grabs 10+ boards. Murray registered 21 points, five rebounds, 12 assists and two steals in 41 minutes for his fourth double-double of the year. It was Murray's second career game (both this season) with 21+ points, 5+ rebounds, 12+ assists and 2+ steals (2-0) and Denver is 9-3 all-time when Murray has 10+ assists in a game.**

## THREE-POINT DUO

When you surround Nikola Jokic with shooters, most of the time he is going to find them for a high percentage shot. So far this season, the trio of Kentavious Caldwell-Pope and Michael Porter Jr. have been knocking down shots at a high clip. Through games on 3/28, the Nuggets have two of the top-25 3FG percentage leaders in the NBA.

## CLUTCH DEFENSE

Denver came out of the All-Star break and picked up right where they left off. The Nuggets earned a 115-109 road victory over the Cleveland Cavaliers on 2/23, moving their record to 42-18 on the season. Despite giving up 31 points in the second quarter and 34 in the third, the Nuggets locked down in the fourth, only allowing 18 points. It marked the second fewest points allowed in a fourth quarter this season. As well, the Cavaliers shot just 6-19 from the field in the fourth (31.6%), the lowest FG% by an opponent in the fourth quarter this season.

**The Nuggets continue to have one of the best clutch time defenses in the NBA this season. Defined as the last five minutes of a game in which the point differential is five or less, Denver ranks first in overall +/-, third in opponent FG%, third in 3FG% and fourth in turnovers forced.**

## +/- = SUCCESS

The Nuggets starters have been dominating throughout the season and their +/- directly correlates to that. They used a strong performance away from home to snap their four-game road losing streak, taking down the Hornets 119-105 on 2/11. The Nuggets had seven different players make at least five field goals, only the 11<sup>th</sup> time in franchise history (last in 2017) that has happened in a road game. As well, all five starters scored 10+ points for the 17<sup>th</sup> times this season, moving to 13-4 in those games. **The Nuggets currently have the top four players for +/- this season, the only team with multiple players in the top-10.**

## A NIGHT TO REMEMBER

The Nuggets had a home and home against the Minnesota Timberwolves and after dropping the first game in Minneapolis, Denver returned the favor at Ball Arena on 2/7. They dominated the game from the jump, going on to win in blowout fashion 148-116. It was a historical night on many levels, a few notes:

- Posted a season-high 146 points, their most points scored since 11/17/17 vs. NOP (146) and their most points ever scored vs. the Timberwolves.
- Scored 49 points in the first quarter, which was a season-high for a quarter and the second most ever in the NBA in a first quarter (51) ... This was also the second most points scored in any quarter in franchise history.
- Had a season-high 44 assists, the most assists since 3/16/08 vs. SEA (44).
- Michael Porter Jr. recorded 30 points (11-15 FG, 4-6 3FG, 4-4 FT) and five rebounds in 29 minutes for his third 30+ point game this season (3-0).

## DROPPING DIMES

The Mile High City has been home to the best offense in the NBA and sharing the ball is a big reason why. The Nuggets currently rank first in the NBA in FG% (.509), first in 3FG% (.398), first in offensive rating (117.9) and second in assists per game (28.8). It was no different in their win over Atlanta on 2/4. The Nuggets handed out 32 assists in the contest, their third straight game with 32+ assists.

**It moved their record to 23-3 overall and 17-1 at home when dishing out 30+ assists this season. As well, from 1989 to 2021 the Nuggets had just one span of three straight games with 32+ assists, since then they have had four such streaks.**

## BLUE ARROW BACK

Jamal Murray has been playing the best basketball of the season and looks like the point guard that we all know and love. It was no different at Ball Arena on 2/4 as Murray helped the Nuggets extend their winning streak to three games with a 128-108 victory over Atlanta. The blue arrow posted a season-high 41 points (15-24 FG, 7-12 3FG, 4-4 FT), five rebounds and seven assists in 36 minutes. Murray made 7+ three-pointers for the sixth time in his career (second time in the last three games), the second most such games by a Nugget in franchise history (Smith, 14).

**Murray has scored 30+ points in three straight games, the sixth time a Nugget has had such a streak since 2011 (Jokic, 6 and Murray, 2). As well, Denver moved to 13-1 this season when he records 25+ points. He has scored 16+ points in 15 straight games, his longest streak of his career.**

## COACH OF THE MONTH

The NBA announced on 2/2 that Nuggets Head Coach Michael Malone was named the Western Conference Coach of the Month for games played in January. Malone earns this honor for the second time in his coaching career (April '21) and is just the third Nuggets coach to win the award multiple times (George Karl, Doug Moe). Additionally, Malone and his coaching staff have secured the top seed in the Western Conference through games played on February 5th, earning them the right to coach Team LeBron in the 2023 NBA All-Star Game.

**Coach Malone led the Nuggets to a 12-4 record (.750) in January, the best record in the entire NBA during that span. The Nuggets won a season-high nine straight games from Jan. 5 to Jan. 20 and they also won nine consecutive home games as part of their season-long 16 game streak during the month as well. Denver ranked 1st in the NBA in Net Rating (+8.0), 4th in offensive rating (119.4) and 4th in defensive rating (111.4) while maintaining the number one seed in the West.**





## CLIMBING THE LIST

Nikola Jokic put together another MVP performance as Nuggets defeated the Philadelphia 76ers at home on 3/27. The Joker registered 25 points (8-11 FG, 9-11 FT), 17 rebounds, 12 assists and two blocks in 35 minutes for his league leading 29th triple-double of the year, it was his first career game with 25+ points, 17+ rebounds, 12+ assists and 2+ blocks and the first player in the NBA this season to do so.

**Jokic is the seventh player in NBA history to post 25/17/12/2 (Abdul-Jabbar, Adams, Bird, Butler, Doncic, and Westbrook). Jokic earned his 105th career triple-double, one behind LeBron James and two behind Jason Kidd on the all-time list. The Nuggets are 27-2 this season when he has one. He has more this season than the next three players combined (Sabonis, 12, Doncic 10, Morant 6).**

## JUST ANOTHER DAY AT THE OFFICE

Nikola Jokic and the Nuggets wrapped up a grueling nine day, five game road trip (their longest since 2022) against the Washington Wizards on 3/22. They used a big third quarter outscoring Washington 39-16 to earn a 118-104 win, ending the trip with a 3-2 record.

**The Nuggets have now had a winning record on each of their last six road trips of five or more games, the last time Denver had a losing record was in March 2018 (went 3-4). Nikola Jokic once again led the way for Denver, posting 31 points (12-16 FG's, 2-3 3FG's, 5-5 FT's), 12 rebounds, seven assists and three steals in 34 minutes. It marked his 18th game this season with at least 30 points, 10 rebounds and five assists, the most in the NBA.**

## BACK-TO-BACK PLAYER OF THE MONTH

The NBA announced on 3/2 that Nikola Jokić was named Western Conference Player of the Month for games played in February. Jokić becomes the first player in franchise history to win the award in back-to-back months and it marks the sixth Player of the Month honor in his career, the most in franchise history.

**The NBA's back-to-back Most Valuable Player averaged 22.6 points, 14.2 rebounds and 10.2 assists while shooting .642 from the field and .500 from three-point range in 11 games during February. He helped lead the Nuggets to a record of 9-2 in games in which he played, and they currently sit atop the Western Conference with a record of 47-23.**

## 100 AND COUNTING

There had previously only been five players in NBA history to record 100 triple doubles in a career, Nikola Jokic just became the sixth. Jokic registered 14 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists in only 28 minutes in the Nuggets 133-112 win over Houston on 2/28, for his 24th triple double of the season and 100th of his career.

**Since the merger in 1976-77, there are only seven teams in the NBA to have recorded over 100 triple doubles (Lakers – 242, Thunder – 185, Nuggets 173, Nets – 135, Celtics – 123, Rockets – 110, Wizards – 103).**

## STREAKING OVER 50.0%

After a tough loss on the first night of a back-to-back to the Grizzlies, the Nuggets returned to a sold-out crowd at Ball Arena against the Los Angeles Clippers on 2/26. Nikola Jokic led the way as Denver took down the Clippers 134-124 in overtime. Jokic recorded 40 points (14-21 FG, 12-15 FT), 17 rebounds, 10 assists and three steals in 42 minutes for his league leading 23rd triple double. It marked his first career game with 40+ points, 17+ rebounds, 10+ assists and 3+ steals and he is only the second player since 1982-83 (Cousins) to put up those numbers.

**The big man joins another list with only himself and Wilt Chamberlain, as the only two players in NBA history to have 40/17/10 in multiple games. As well, Jokic shot .500 or better in 51 straight games, the longest active streak in the NBA this season and the third longest in NBA history.**

## TRIPLE DOUBLE MACHINE

Nikola Jokić continues to amaze, night in and night out. The Joker and the Nuggets came out of the All-Star break and earned a hard-fought road win 115-109 against the Cleveland Cavaliers on 2/23. Jokić finished with 24 points (8-13 FG's, 2-2 3FG's, 6-6 FT's), 13 assists, 18 rebounds and two steals in 35 minutes for his league leading 22nd triple-double of the year. The Nuggets have now won 34 of the last 37, when he gets 10+ assists.

**Jokic has been on a tear as of late, recording a triple double in 18 of his last 25 games overall. The Nuggets also are 27-2 this season when he records a triple double. He is also one of five players in NBA history to have three or more streaks of four straight triple doubles in a career. Dating back to last season, the Nuggets have gone 29-2 when he records a triple double, they previously had won 29 straight games, the longest such win streak in NBA history.**

## 500/500 BEFORE ALL-STAR

As one of the best passers in the NBA, Nikola Jokić consistently ranks at the top of the NBA in assists but this year he is doing it at an historical rate. Jokić helped the Nuggets cap a three-game road trip with a 2-1 record after taking down the Miami Heat on 2/13. The Joker finished with 27 points on 12-14 shooting, 12 rebounds and eight assists in 34 minutes. **He once again joins elite company, becoming the first center in NBA history and only the third player to record 500+ assists and 500+ rebounds before the All-Star break.**

## SETTING FRANCHISE RECORDS

Season after season Nikola Jokić continues to rack up the triple doubles, and now he has recorded the most in a single season in franchise history. The Joker posted 30 points (11-22 FG's), 16 rebounds and 10 assists in 34 minutes for his 20<sup>th</sup> triple double of the season as the Nuggets snapped their four-game road losing streak at Charlotte on 2/11. It marked his seventh career triple double with 30+ points and 15+ rebounds, joining Oscar Robertson and Wilt Chamberlain as the only players with multiple.

**Jokić passes his mark from last season for the most in a single season in Nuggets history and he is only the fifth player in NBA history to record 20+ triple doubles in a single season (Robertson 5x, Westbrook 4x, Chamberlain 1x, Harden 1x).**

## FIRST HALF WIZARD

With the Nuggets home and home against the Minnesota Timberwolves on 2/5 and 2/7, Nikola Jokić missed the first matchup due to left hamstring tightness as the Nuggets took the road loss. The big man returned to the starting lineup at home and dominated the next game. Jokić registered 20 points (8-10 FG, 4-5 FT), 12 rebounds and 16 assists in 28 minutes for his league leading 19th triple-double and his third career game (second this season) with 20+ points, 12+ rebounds and 16+ assists.

**He recorded the triple-double in the first half, the second time he has done so in his career (he owns the fastest triple double in NBA history doing so in 14:33 minutes) and joins Russell Westbrook as the only two players in NBA history to do so multiple times. He also ties his own Nugget franchise record with 19 triple-doubles in a single season.**

## PLAYER OF THE MONTH

The NBA announced on 2/2 that Denver Nuggets center Nikola Jokić was named the Western Conference Player of the Month for games played in January. Jokić wins the award for the first time this season and the fifth time in his career, the most Player of the Month honors in franchise history. The NBA's back-to-back Most Valuable Player averaged 24.0 points, 11.6 rebounds, 11.3 assists and 1.20 steals while shooting .677 from the field and .538 from three-point range in 12 games during January. He helped lead the Nuggets to a record of 10-2 in games in which he played.

**He recorded eight triple-doubles in January including posting one in five of his last six games to end the month, adding to his league-leading 17 for the season. He joins Wilt Chamberlain as the only centers in NBA history to record eight or more triple doubles in a single month. Jokić also became the first player to have shooting splits of .650 from the field, .500 from three and .850 from the free throw line in a month.**

## 5X ALL-STAR

The NBA announced on 1/26 that Nuggets center Nikola Jokić was selected as a starter for the 2023 NBA All-Star game on Sunday, Feb. 19 at Vivint Arena in Salt Lake City. This is Jokić's fifth straight All-Star selection, and third consecutive year being named an All-Star Starter.

**He joins Alex English and David Thompson as the only Nugget players to be selected to start in consecutive All-Star games and is just the second Nuggets player ever to be selected to five-or-more All-Star games (English).**

## NUGGETS ASSIST KING

Nikola Jokić has been dishing the rock all month long but his recent stretch has been the best of the season. He finished with 31 points, 13 assists, 11 rebounds and one steal in 31 minutes to help the Nuggets take down the Timberwolves on 1/18. **It marked Jokić's third straight game with 10+ assists and his 11<sup>th</sup> game in the last 16 he has had double digit assists. He currently ranks second in the NBA in total assists and second in assists per game. Additionally, Jokić passed Alex English for the franchise leader in assists.**

Jokić helped lead the Nuggets to a win over the Timberwolves on 1/18, registering 31 points (12-20 FG, 7-7 FT), 13 assists and 11 rebounds in 35 minutes for his league leading 14th double-double of the year. **The Joker has now led the Nuggets in points, rebounds, and assists 99 times in his career, marking the most such games by a center in NBA history.**

It was also the second time in his career that he has had a 30-point triple-double on 90% FG pct shooting. He & Wilt Chamberlain are the only players with such games in NBA history.**

Michael Malone enters his eighth season as head coach of the Denver Nuggets. He was named the 16th head coach in Denver's NBA franchise history on June 15, 2015. He is now the fourth longest tenured coach in the NBA and currently ranks third all-time amongst Nuggets head coaches with 314 wins.

Last season saw Coach Malone lead the Nuggets to a 48-34 record as they clinched a playoff berth for the fourth straight year. Denver finished the season setting a franchise record with 25 road wins and secured the sixth seed in the Western Conference playoffs while being shorthanded due to injuries throughout the season.

Despite missing Jamal Murray in two straight postseasons, Malone has helped lead the Nuggets to a playoff series victory in three of the last four seasons. Since 2018-19, Denver has four playoff series victories, which matches the franchise total for the previous 32 years. Malone has totaled 21 postseason wins, which is tied for second all-time in franchise history trailing Doug Moe by three for first.

Since Malone has taken over prior to the 2015-16 season, the Nuggets have seen the postseason on four occasions including a Western Conference Finals appearance in 2020, the first for the franchise since 2009. The Nuggets are also second in the NBA, trailing only the Milwaukee Bucks for the most combined regular season and postseason wins in a four-year span with 216. Additionally, based on winning percentage, Malone has overseen three of the top ten seasons in NBA franchise history.

Malone has 353 victories as an NBA head coach and possesses over 25 years of coaching experience, 21 coming in the NBA with six different teams – New York, Cleveland, New Orleans, Golden State, Sacramento and Denver. The teams that Malone has been a member of the coaching staff have amassed 13 playoff appearances, including one NBA Finals showing and three conference finals appearances. Malone and his staff also were selected to coach Team LeBron at the 2019 NBA All-Star game in Charlotte, NC, defeating Team Giannis 178-164.

Before joining the Nuggets, Malone served as the head coach of the Sacramento Kings for two seasons. Before his time with the Kings, Malone was the lead assistant for the Golden State Warriors under Mark Jackson from 2011-13 where they clinched a postseason berth in 2013, their first since 2007.

Prior to Golden State, Malone worked as the lead assistant to Monty Williams in New Orleans and helped the Hornets achieve a 46-36 record and a trip to the 2011 NBA Playoffs. The Hornets were the most improved defensive team in the NBA in 2011, allowing a league-best 8.7 fewer points per game than in the previous campaign (94.0 ppg, after giving up 102.7 ppg in 2009-10).

Malone also served as an assistant coach under Mike Brown for the Cleveland Cavaliers for five seasons, during which the Cavs posted a 272-138 (.663) record, the third-best mark in the NBA over that span. The Cavaliers made five consecutive playoff appearances during Malone's time on the bench, reaching the NBA Finals in 2007 and the Eastern Conference Finals in 2009. In 2008-09, the Cavs notched a franchise record and NBA-best 66 wins, with Malone and the rest of the team's staff earning the right to coach the Eastern Conference All-Star squad. In 2009-10, the Cavaliers again captured the league's best regular season record with 61 wins.

Malone's NBA coaching career began with a four-season stint with the New York Knicks, where he originally joined Jeff Van Gundy's staff as a coaching associate in the summer of 2001, and was promoted to assistant coach in May 2003.

Before joining the NBA, Malone coached seven years in the college ranks, with his last stop coming at Manhattan College where he was the lead assistant. During the 1998-99 season Malone worked at the University of Virginia as its director of men's basketball administration. Malone also spent three seasons (1995-96 – 1997-98) at Providence College under New York Basketball Hall of Fame coach Pete Gillen after beginning his coaching career working for Greg Kampe at Oakland University in Michigan.

Malone is a three-time participant in the NBA's "Basketball Without Borders" program, having coached at the league's global outreach camps in Africa (2017), Puerto Rico (2006) and Argentina (2005). In 2017 Malone traveled to Johannesburg, South Africa where he spent a week coaching at the BWB camps and then served as an assistant coach for Team Africa, for the NBA Africa Game 2017.

Malone also served as an assistant coach for the Canadian Men's Senior National Team for three years. He helped guide the Canadian team to a top-four finish in the 2009 FIBA Americas Championship in Puerto Rico, qualifying Canada for the 2010 World Championships.

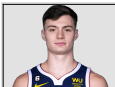
A native of Queens, New York, Malone played college basketball at Loyola College in Maryland, where he graduated with a BA degree in 1994. He is a graduate of New Jersey's Seton Hall Prep where he played two years under Bob Farrell. Malone also played a season under Tom Blackburn at Worcester Academy (Mass.).

Michael is the son of longtime NBA coach Brendan Malone, who has coached over 28 years in the league.

He and his wife, Jocelyn, have two daughters, Caitlin and Bridget.
