## 5.0 Organization of the Event

All Red Book requirements will be met. There will be round robin games and then a double elimination tournament.

Each team will have 6 to 10 players.

There will be a general and a women-only division in the following categories:

- Top Competitive AA
- Competitive A
- Advanced BB
- Average B
- Recreational C

Women can compete on men's teams.

It will depend on the number of teams registered.

Standard policy applies. We will offer a women-only division. Women can compete in the general division as well.

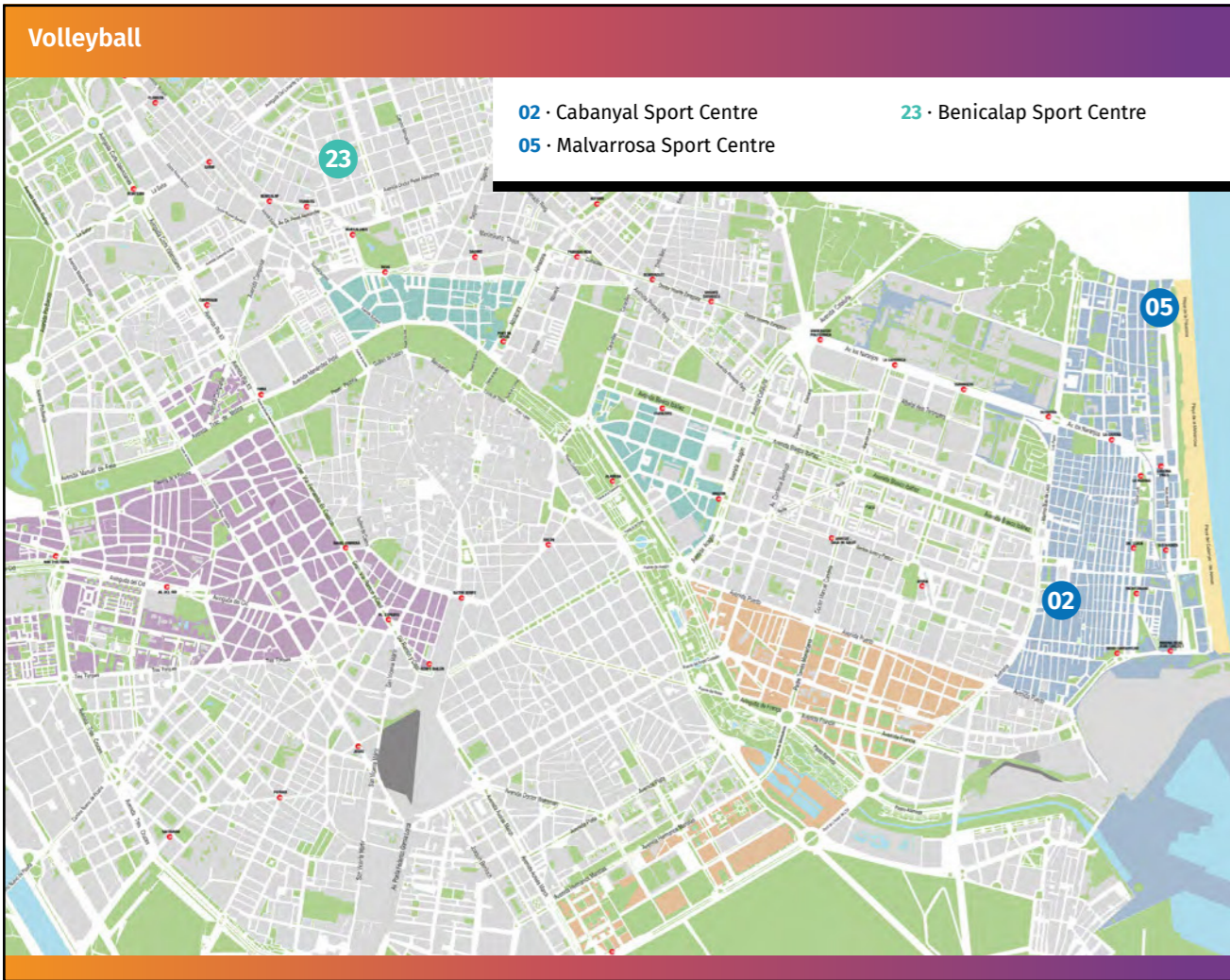
### 6.4 How will you address requirements of Policy guidelines for Health and Well-being, and in particular, Performance-Enhancing Drugs?
