In May 2012, the US Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) adopted the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labeling of Chemicals (GHS), as introduced during HazCom 2012.

The new GHS specifies a change in document name from the old Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) to the new Safety Data Sheet (SDS) and includes 16 specific sections in a strict order.

Companies must establish newly compliant Safety Data Sheets by December 1, 2013.

As a result of OSHA's adoption of the new GHS, in September 2013, Certified Lye's former Material Safety Data Sheet for lye (sodium hydroxide) has been replaced by a new Safety Data Sheet for lye (sodium hydroxide).
