COURMAYEUR, Italy (AP)—Snow slides killed at least three workmen on the Mt. Blanc tunnel project early today as miners on an alpine tunnel 12 miles away celebrated their conquest of nature.

Poor-Grade Student Ruled Rifle Suicide

ITHACA (AP)—A chemical engineering student who was on probation at Cornell University because of poor grades shot himself to death after telling his fraternity brothers he was going target shooting, state police said today.

Coroner Ralph Low said Uri Hans Bardfeld, 20, of Vineland, N.J., committed suicide by shooting himself with a .22-caliber rifle in a rural area south of here. Searchers found his body yesterday, 75 yards from a road in the Town of Danby.

Troopers described the youth as "withdrawn from other students." He had been missing since Tuesday. The kingfisher is sometimes called "Old Tausle-top."
