If you need an independent minded astronomer who is a contributor to Science Digest, someone like William Kaufmann or Wallace Tucker would be most appropriate.

All of us in the science press have an obligation to work to educate the public on the differences between science and pseudo-science (see the enclosed ad from the publishers of <u>Discover</u>.) In giving Dr. Hynek further platforms from which to obfuscate that difference, I feel you have done your magazine and scientific awards a disservice.
