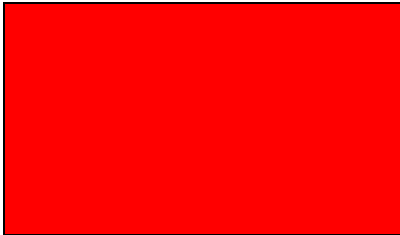

Accreditation

ACCREDITATION APPLICATION REQUEST – Deadline 1st April 2024

Access to transport services and **Hi-Tech Zone Sports Centre Gymnasium** is provided through personalised and photographic accreditation, which will be strictly monitored throughout the Tournament.

The fee to replace lost and damaged accreditation pass will be at USD 200 per pass on each occasion and it will be charged to the respective Member as well.

Accreditation will be available for collection after check-in to the hotel. The accreditation shall be collected by the Team Manager **ONLY**. If the Member has incurred a charge for additional passes, this will be payable at this time – cash payment only.

The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, penalties being applied.

5. Thomas & Uber Cup: The Trophies

Thomas & Uber Cup

The Thomas Cup & Uber Cup is an exceptional piece of workmanship; it brings together elements of badminton and named after the persons behind the development of the tournament.

The **Thomas Cup** is the handsome prize awarded for the **World Men's Team Championships**. Its name honours Sir George Thomas, legendary Founder-President of the International Badminton Federation (now BWF), who was keen that badminton should have its own version of the Davis Cup in tennis.

The **World Women's Team Championships** was proposed in 1950 by England's great pre-War player Betty Uber (supported by New Zealand's Nancy Fleming), and eventually came into being in 1956-57. The trophy, whose name honours Betty Uber who donated and designed the trophy.

ATA Carnet

The Thomas & Uber Cup travel with an ATA Carnet documentation – an ATA Carnet is like a passport for merchandise, and it is an international document that permits the tax-free and duty-free temporary admission of goods into multiple countries.

Logistics & Cost

The Thomas Cup's total weights with its flight case is 35 kilograms and its flight case measures 42 cm x 40 cm x 48 cm. While The Uber Cup's total weights with its flight case is 22 kilograms and its flight case measures 33 cm x 33 cm x 52 cm.

The costs to bring the Thomas & Uber Cup back to the winning country and return to the BWF will have to be borne by the winning Team.
