

## **EX-SENATOR ROBERTS KILLED.**

**UTICA, N. Y., Sept. 3.**—At 4 o'clock this afternoon Ex-Senator Robert H. Roberts was instantly killed in his boatyard in Boonville. He was knocking a block out from the side of a boat that was building, when it fell on him, breaking his neck. He was 51 years old. He was born in Wales, and came to Boonville from the oil regions in 1876. He was Democratic Supervisor several times from that Republican town, once a member of the Assembly, and once State Senator from the Oneida district.
