**S. R. Pugno, French Pianist, Dead.**

Stephen Raoul Pugno, foremost French pianist since the retirement of Camille Saint-Saens, died Saturday at Moscow while on a visit to Russia. He had made several tours of the United States, the last two years ago. Born in Paris in 1853, he became an organist at 19 and later wrote pantomimes, ballets, operas, operettas and oratorios.
