

# **CLUB HISTORY**

Gedling Miners Welfare FC was formed in 1919, at the same time as the Notts Alliance Football league resumed playing football again after the First World War. In our first Season we finished 3rd in the League and won the League Cup by defeating Speinton FC 1 - 0.

At the end of the 1929-30 Season the Club changed its name and became known as Mapperley St. Judes and enjoyed moderate success during this period. During the Second World War we reformed as Gedling Miners Welfare FC and with the restart of football for the 1945-46 Season we went on to win both the Notts Alliance League and Notts Alliance Senior Cup. This was repeated on numerous occasions and this success spilled over into the 1950s, which was the most successful period of the Club. We won the Notts Alliance League and Cup Double many times and at one point remained unbeaten for three seasons.

In the FA Amateur Cup we entertained two of the top sides of the time. Pegasus were the visitors to Plains Road in 1954 and temporary stands were erected all around the Ground to house a crowd of 7,000 plus. Two Seasons later Bishop Auckland visited and the Police put a limit of 10,000 on the Gate. We lost 4 - 1 to the best amateur team in the country. having missed a penalty at a crucial point in the game. The 'Bishops' had six amateur England Internationals on show and the most famous being Bob Hardisty who was the Captain of England. The staggering record attendance at Plains Road, will surely never again be surpass.

We now look forward to the 22/23 season under the joint leadership of long serving manager Andy Clerke and newly appointed joint manger Stephen Kirkham. Stephen and Andrew Nicholson join the management team alongside Assistant Manager Tony Mullen and Coach Dan Mehigan.

# HUCHHALL TOWH

DOMINANT GEDLING BEAT LOCAL RIVALS HUCKNALL TOWN.

It was the hosts who started the brighter and on 4 minutes they should have taken the lead. After Gedling failed to close down a cross it found the unmarked Joe Ashurst who headed wide of the target from 6 yards. Gedling found their feet and on the 10-minute mark they were close to breaking the deadlock. After Tyrell Shannon-Lewis and Romello Nangle combined well Nangle played through Courtney Hastings who beat his man but his effort crashed the inside of the post and Nangle's follow up was well blocked. Just 4 minutes later Josh Thornton ran through and he knocked it around the onrushing vellows keeper Louis Kinnerley but the angle was too tight and Thornton's effort hit the side netting. The game was really close with few chances until the 39th minute when the visitors took the lead, debutant Jahren Barrow did well to beat his man before playing a great ball to Nangle who smashed a right footed effort across Kinnerley and into the bottom left corner for his 6th goal of the season and to send Gedling 1 up at the interval.

On 53 minutes Gedling's shot stopper Louis Richardson did well to prevent Keiran Knight who had got in behind the Gedling backline but this was as good as it got for Hucknall as Gedling began to take control of the game. On 69 minutes the miners deservedly extended their advantage. Kieran Harrison played a great ball to Shannon-Lewis who took it down brilliantly then he flicked the ball over the Hucknall full back and drove into the area before cutting the ball back to Thornton and the Gedling captain placed his effort into the bottom right-hand corner.

Gedling defended brilliantly all night and limited Hucknall to long shots and the forwards continued to press the Hucknall back line and this was enough to give the miners a deserved win for their 2nd league win of the season.

CLUB HISTORY A Belper United was established around 1908. By the early 1980s the club was playing in the East Midlands Regional League. This became the Midlands Regional Alliance in 1985. and Belper were its first Premier Division champions in 1985-86.

They won the league's Challenge Cup in 1992-93, before securing a second Premier Division title in 1994-95 and another Challenge Cup the following season. They were later relegated to Division One, which they won in the 2004-05 season to earn promotion back to the Premier Division, Despite finishing bottom of the Premier Division in 2008-09, Belper were not relegated to Division One.

In 2010 they switched to the South Division of the Central Midlands League. In 2014-15 they won the Central Midlands League Floodlight Cup, beating Clay Cross Town 3-2 in the final. After finishing as runners-up in the South Division in 2015-16, the club were promoted to the East Midlands Counties League.
