
EXTREME TEMPERATURES OF MONTH NOVEMBER


Note: The Minimum temperature extremes are usually recorded in Nepal during the Winter months (December- January) especially in the month of January and rarely in some cases the extremes are recorded in other months. November is the driest of all the months and most of the time there is no rain in this month. Though this is not the coldest month the temperatures are sometime recorded minimum in some of the stations. Among the stations selected in this monitoring the maximum temperature recorded in the June month in the station at Dipayal in the Far-western region of Nepal of 35.2°C on 4th November 2001 and for the minimum temperature recorded in the February month in the station at Jumla in the Mid-western region of Nepal of -6.8°C on 28th November 1982 and 2003. The minimum temperature of shows no trend in most of the cases and slightly increasing or decreasing trend in some of the cases. Whereas the maximum temperature shows slightly increasing trend in most of the cases and no trend in few cases but the falling trend in Dipayal.





































